



HOUSE BILL No. 4079

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Gubow, Saunders and Gire and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 270 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the release of certain information or data relating to health care research or education, health care entities, practitioners, or professions, or certain governmentally funded programs; to limit the liability with respect to the release of certain information or data; and to safeguard the confidential character of certain information or data,"

as amended by Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of 1992, being section 331.532 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 270 of the Public Acts of
2 1967, as amended by Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of 1992, being
3 section 331.532 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

1 Sec. 2. The release or publication of a record of the
2 proceedings or of the reports, findings, and conclusions of a
3 review entity shall be for 1 or more of the following purposes:

4 (a) To advance health care research or health care
5 education.

6 (b) To maintain the standards of the health care
7 professions.

8 (c) To protect the financial integrity of any governmentally
9 funded program.

10 (d) To provide evidence relating to the ethics or discipline
11 of a health care provider, entity, or practitioner.

12 (e) To review the qualifications, competence, and per-
13 formance of a health care professional with respect to the selec-
14 tion and appointment of the health care professional to the medi-
15 cal staff of a health facility.

16 (F) TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 20175 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,
17 ACT NO. 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTION 333.20175
18 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

19 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
20 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4076 (request
21 no. 01607'93) of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law.
