- 6 SION OF A PEACE OFFICER LAWFULLY PERFORMING HIS OR HER DUTIES AS
- 7 A PEACE OFFICER IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT
- 8 FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00,
- 9 OR BOTH.
