

HOUSE BILL No. 4196

A bill to amend Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled

"Executive organization act of 1965,"

as amended, being sections 16.101 to 16.608 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 478.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, as
- 2 amended, being sections 16.101 to 16.608 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 478 to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 478. THE STATE OFFICE OF RECIPIENT RIGHTS IS CREATED
- 5 AS AN AUTONOMOUS AGENCY IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL RIGHTS. THE
- 6 STATE OFFICE OF RECIPIENT RIGHTS SHALL EXERCISE, INDEPENDENTLY OF
- 7 THE CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION, THE POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS
- 8 DESCRIBED IN CHAPTER 7A OF THE MENTAL HEALTH CODE, ACT NO. 258 OF
- 9 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1974, BEING SECTIONS 330.1755 TO 330.1759 OF

- 1 THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. ALL BUDGETING, PROCUREMENT, AND
- 2 RELATED MANAGEMENT FUNCTIONS SHALL BE PERFORMED UNDER THE DIREC-
- 3 TION AND SUPERVISION OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION. THE HEAD OF
- 4 THE OFFICE OF RECIPIENT RIGHTS IS THE DIRECTOR OF RECIPIENT
- 5 RIGHTS, WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT
- 6 OF CIVIL RIGHTS.
