



HOUSE BILL No. 4264

February 17, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Joe Young, Jr. and Murphy and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 246 of the Public Acts of 1982,
entitled

"An act to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Washtenaw county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by adding section 3a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 246 of the Public Acts of 1982 is
2 amended by adding section 3a to read as follows:

3 SEC. 3A. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 3(A) AND (D), THE STATE
4 ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH YORK TOWN-
5 SHIP BY WHICH YORK TOWNSHIP MAY SELL PART OF THE PROPERTY
6 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 FOR FAIR MARKET VALUE AND PLACE THE PRO-
7 CEEDS OF THAT SALE IN A SEPARATE FUND TO BE USED SOLELY FOR THE
8 PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE PROPERTY FOR

1 PARK AND RECREATION PURPOSES. IF YORK TOWNSHIP SELLS PART OF THE
2 PROPERTY AS ALLOWED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE AGREEMENT WITH THE
3 STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD ALLOWING THAT SALE SHALL PROVIDE THAT
4 THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE PROPERTY SHALL CONTINUE TO BE
5 SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS IMPOSED UNDER SECTION 3(A).
