

HOUSE BILL No. 4266

February 17, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Joe Young, Jr. and Murphy and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Leelanau county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for the disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to Bingham township, for \$1.00, certain prop-
- 3 erty now under the jurisdiction of the department of mental
- 4 health and located in Bingham township, Leelanau county, and more
- 5 specifically described as follows:
- All of Government Lot Three (3) of Section Twenty-eight (28)
- 7 in Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Eleven (11) West, lying
- 8 South of the East and West Highway, and East of the North and
- 9 South Highway, Section Twenty-eight (28) Township Twenty-nine

- 1 (29) North, Range Eleven (11) West, according to the United 2 States Survey thereof.
- 3 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by section 1 shall pro-
- 4 vide that the property conveyed shall be used for the purpose of
- 5 a public park which shall be open to all residents of the state
- 6 on the same terms, fees, and conditions, and that upon termina-
- 7 tion of that use, or upon use for any other purpose, title to the
- 8 property shall revert immediately to the state, with the state
- 9 assuming no liability for any improvements made by Bingham
- 10 township.
- 11 Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by section 1 shall be by
- 12 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general, and shall
- 13 reserve to the state all rights to oil, coal, gas, or other mate-
- 14 rials, excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetallic miner-
- 15 als found on, within, or under the conveyed land.
- 16 Sec. 4. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 17 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
