A bill to amend Act No. 261 of the Public Acts of 1957,  
entitled as amended  
"Michigan legislative retirement system act,"  
as amended, being sections 38.1001 to 38.1060 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 23a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Act No. 261 of the Public Acts of 1957, as  
2 amended, being sections 38.1001 to 38.1060 of the Michigan  
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 23a to read as  
4 follows:

5 SEC. 23A. (1) THE BOARD SHALL SUSPEND THE RETIREMENT ALLOW-  
6 ANCE OF A RETIRANT IF THE RETIRANT IS OR BECOMES EMPLOYED BY THIS  
7 STATE. THE BOARD SHALL SUSPEND THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE  
8 EFFECTIVE THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE DATE THE  
9 RETIRANT IS EMPLOYED BY THIS STATE OR EFFECTIVE THE FIRST DAY OF

1 THE MONTH IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS  
2 SECTION IF THE RETIRANT IS EMPLOYED BY THIS STATE ON THE EFFEC-  
3 TIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION. THE BOARD SHALL REINSTATE THE  
4 RETIRANT'S RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER THIS ACT WITHOUT CHANGE IN  
5 AMOUNT OR CONDITIONS EFFECTIVE THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOW-  
6 ING THE DATE THE RETIRANT IS NO LONGER EMPLOYED BY THIS STATE.

7 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF THE RETIRANT AGAIN  
8 BECOMES A LEGISLATOR OR LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR AND IS SUBJECT TO  
9 SECTION 23B.
