



HOUSE BILL No. 4397

March 2, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Byrum, Willard, Freeman, Baade, Agee, Dobronski, DeMars, Gire, Clack, Johnson, Sikkema, Dobb, Bullard, Fitzgerald, Dolan, Stille, Yokich, Brown, Gubow, Scott, Profit, McBryde, Wetters, Anthony, Joe Young, Jr. and Cropsey and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 15c of chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended "The code of criminal procedure," as added by Act No. 222 of the Public Acts of 1985, being section 764.15c of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 15c of chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the
2 Public Acts of 1927, as added by Act No. 222 of the Public Acts
3 of 1985, being section 764.15c of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
4 amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER IV

6 Sec. 15c. After intervening in a domestic dispute as
7 described in section 15a or 15b, a peace officer shall advise the
8 victim of the availability of a shelter program or other services
9 in the community and give the victim the statutory notice set

1 forth in this act. The notice shall include furnishing the
 2 victim with a listing of the phone numbers of area shelter pro-
 3 gram services and a copy of the following statement:

4 "Information about shelters and alternatives to domestic
 5 violence is available from a statewide 24-hour toll-free hotline
 6 at (number to be listed). The battered women's shelter and other
 7 resources in your area are (include local information).

8 If you are the victim of domestic violence you can ask the
 9 county prosecuting attorney to file a criminal complaint.

10 You also have the right to go to court and file a petition
 11 requesting an injunctive order from domestic abuse which could
 12 include the following:

13 (a) An order restraining or enjoining the abuser from enter-
 14 ing onto premises.

15 (b) An order restraining or enjoining the abuser from
 16 assaulting, beating, molesting, or wounding you.

17 (C) AN ORDER RESTRAINING OR ENJOINING THE ABUSER FROM
 18 THREATENING TO KILL OR PHYSICALLY INJURE YOU.

19 (D) ~~-(c)-~~ An order restraining or enjoining the abuser from
 20 removing minor children from you, except as otherwise authorized
 21 by a custody or visitation order issued by a court of competent
 22 jurisdiction."

23 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
 24 all of the following bills of the 87th Legislature are enacted
 25 into law:
