



# HOUSE BILL No. 4426

March 3, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Lowe, Middaugh, Gernaat, Horton, Alley, Goschka, Voorhees, Walberg, McManus, DeMars, Rhead and Kukuk and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the protection and conservation of the natural resources of the state; to provide and develop facilities for outdoor recreation; to create a conservation department; to define the powers and duties thereof; to provide rules and regulations concerning the use and occupancy of lands and property under its control and penalties for the violation thereof; to provide for the transfer to said department of the powers and duties now vested by law in certain boards, commissions and officers of the state; and for the abolishing of the boards, commissions and offices the powers and duties of which are hereby transferred,"

as amended, being sections 299.1 to 299.10 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 8a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, as  
2 amended, being sections 299.1 to 299.10 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 8a to read as follows:

1        SEC. 8A. (1) THE MACMULLAN CONFERENCE CENTER SHALL BE  
2 AVAILABLE ONLY TO THE FOLLOWING:

3        (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

4        (B) FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

5        (C) EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS.

6        (D) NONPROFIT ENTITIES THAT HAVE A NATURAL RESOURCE AGENDA  
7 AS ALL OR A PORTION OF THEIR MISSION.

8        (E) COMMUNITY SERVICE CLUBS THAT HAVE A STATEWIDE  
9 MEMBERSHIP.

10       (F) HANDICAPPER GROUPS.

11       (2) THE STATE SHALL ASSURE THAT EACH ENTITY THAT IS ELIGIBLE  
12 TO USE THE MACMULLAN CONFERENCE CENTER SHALL RECEIVE A PRESENTA-  
13 TION REGARDING THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION  
14 PROGRAMS IN THIS STATE.
