

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4485**

March 11, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Bennane, Gubow, DeMars and Munsell and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend sections 16131 and 16263 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended "Public health code,"

section 16131 as amended by Act No. 473 of the Public Acts of 1988 and section 16263 as amended by Act No. 216 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 333.16131 and 333.16263 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add part 185.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Sections 16131 and 16263 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, sections 16131 as amended by Act No. 473 of the Public Acts of 1988 and section 16263 as amended by Act No. 216 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 333.16131 and 5 333.16263 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended and part 185 6 is added to read as follows:

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Sec. 16131. The terms of office of individual members of the council or the boards and task forces, except those appointed to fill vacancies, shall expire 4 years after appointment as follows:

- 9 OF ANY OTHER PROFESSION WHO PRACTICES HIS OR HER PROFESSION AS
- 10 AUTHORIZED BY LAW, IF THAT INDIVIDUAL DOES NOT HOLD HIMSELF OR
- 11 HERSELF OUT TO THE PUBLIC AS A LABORATORY SCIENTIST, LABORATORY
- 12 TECHNICIAN, OR LABORATORY PRACTITIONER LICENSED UNDER THIS
- 13 ARTICLE.
- 14 SEC. 18509. (1) THE MICHIGAN BOARD OF LABORATORY TESTING IS
- 15 CREATED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT. THE BOARD SHALL COMPLY WITH
- 16 PART 161 AND SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING 7 MEMBERS:
- 17 (A) AT LEAST 1 PERSON ENGAGED PRIMARILY IN THE PRACTICE OF
