

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4498**

March 16, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Harder, Barns, Griffin and Rhead and referred to the Committee on Public Retirement.

A bill to amend Act No. 234 of the Public Acts of 1992, entitled

"The judges retirement act of 1992,"
being sections 38.2101 to 38.2608 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
by adding sections 510 and 511.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 234 of the Public Acts of 1992, being
- 2 sections 38.2101 to 38.2608 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended by adding sections 510 and 511 to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 510. (1) EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 1993, THE RETIREMENT
- 5 ALLOWANCE PAYABLE TO A RETIRANT OR BENEFICIARY OF A DECEASED
- 6 RETIRANT WHOSE EFFECTIVE DATE OF RETIREMENT WAS BEFORE JANUARY 1,
- 7 1980, EXCEPT A RETIRANT OR BENEFICIARY OF A DECEASED RETIRANT WHO
- 8 WAS A MEMBER OF THE FORMER JUDGES RETIREMENT SYSTEM BEFORE
- 9 SEPTEMBER 8, 1961, IS SUPPLEMENTED AS FOLLOWS:

- 16 (2) THE RECALCULATED RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE SHALL BE THE BASIS
  17 ON WHICH FUTURE ADJUSTMENTS TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE ARE
  18 CALCULATED.
- 19 (3) THE SUPPLEMENT PROVIDED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE CALCU20 LATED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1) AND SHALL BE PAID BEFORE
- 21 OCTOBER 1, 1993. IF A RETIRANT DIES BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 1993 AND
- 22 NO BENEFITS BECOME PAYABLE UNDER SECTION 506 OR 508, THE
- 23 RETIRANT'S RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE SHALL NOT BE SUPPLEMENTED UNDER
- 24 THIS SECTION.

SEC. 511. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE 2 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE PAYABLE TO A RETIRANT WHOSE EFFECTIVE DATE 3 OF RETIREMENT WAS BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1980 OR TO AN OPTION A BENE-A FICIARY OF A DECEASED RETIRANT WHOSE EFFECTIVE DATE OF RETIREMENT 5 WAS BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1980, AS SUPPLEMENTED BY SECTION 510 IF 6 APPLICABLE, SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN \$10,000.00 PER ANNUM IF THE 7 RETIRANT HAD AT LEAST 8 YEARS OF SERVICE CREDITED UNDER THE 8 FORMER JUDGES RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR THE FORMER PROBATE JUDGES 9 RETIREMENT SYSTEM. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE 10 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE PAYABLE TO A BENEFICIARY, OTHER THAN AN 11 OPTION A BENEFICIARY, OF A DECEASED RETIRANT WHOSE EFFECTIVE DATE 12 OF RETIREMENT WAS BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1980, AS SUPPLEMENTED BY SEC-13 TION 510 IF APPLICABLE, SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN \$8,500.00 PER 14 ANNUM IF THE RETIRANT HAD AT LEAST 8 YEARS OF SERVICE CREDITED 15 UNDER THE FORMER JUDGES RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR THE FORMER PROBATE 16 JUDGES RETIREMENT SYSTEM. THE PAYMENT OF AN INCREASED RETIREMENT 17 ALLOWANCE UNDER THIS SECTION IS EFFECTIVE ON OCTOBER 1, 1993 AND 18 IS NOT PAYABLE FOR ANY MONTH BEGINNING BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 1993. (2) FOR A RETIRANT OR BENEFICIARY OF A DECEASED RETIRANT WHO 19 20 IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN INCREASED RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER 21 SUBSECTION (1) AND WHO IS RECEIVING AN ANNUITY OR RETIREMENT 22 ALLOWANCE FROM ANOTHER PUBLICLY SUPPORTED RETIREMENT SYSTEM 23 ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE SAME YEARS OF SERVICE, OTHER THAN FEDERAL 24 SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS, THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE PAYABLE TO 25 THAT RETIRANT OR BENEFICIARY SHALL BE THE AMOUNT SPECIFIED IN 26 SUBSECTION (1) MINUS THE AMOUNT OF THE ANNUITY OR RETIREMENT 27 ALLOWANCE PAYABLE FROM THE OTHER PUBLICLY SUPPORTED RETIREMENT

- 1 SYSTEM, BUT NOT LESS THAN THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AS
- 2 SUPPLEMENTED BY SECTION 510, IF APPLICABLE, OR NOT LESS THAN THE
- 3 ANNUITY PAYABLE UNDER THIS ACT ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1993.
