



HOUSE BILL No. 4520

March 23, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Jaye and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended "The insurance code of 1956," as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 2027a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 2027a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 2027A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 3408, ISSUING
6 A DISABILITY POLICY OR CERTIFICATE THAT EXCLUDES, LIMITS, OR
7 REDUCES COVERAGE FOR THE HIV OR HEPATITIS B VIRUS IS AN UNFAIR
8 METHOD OF COMPETITION AND AN UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE ACT OR PRACTICE
9 IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE.

1 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HIV" MEANS THAT TERM AS
2 DEFINED IN SECTION 5101 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, ACT NO. 368 OF
3 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTION 333.5101 OF THE MICHIGAN
4 COMPILED LAWS.

5 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
6 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4519 (request
7 no. 03322'93) of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law.
