



HOUSE BILL No. 4715

May 5, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 1408 of Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled as amended
"Occupational code,"
being section 339.1408 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1408 of Act No. 299 of the Public Acts
2 of 1980, being section 339.1408 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1408. A person registered under this article shall be
5 subject to the penalties set forth in article 6 for any of the
6 following:

7 (a) Failing to make identifying marks ~~, as registered with~~
8 ~~the department of state police,~~ on the inside of the cases of
9 watches held for repair. The department shall assign each
10 registered horologist an identification casemark. A list of

1 casemarks shall be maintained by the department ~~and filed with~~
2 ~~the department of state police~~ and shall be made available to a
3 law enforcement agency upon request. Upon request of the owner
4 of the watch the casemark shall be on a sticker affixed to the
5 case of the watch.

6 (b) Failing to keep proper repair records showing the names
7 and addresses of persons leaving watches for repair.
