

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4738**

May 11, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Yokich, Profit, Voorhees, Jamian, Rivers, Pitoniak, Dalman, Shepich, DeMars, Gire, Freeman and Bodem and referred to the Committee on Tourism and Recreation.

A bill to amend section 78 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled as amended

"Marine safety act,"

being section 281.1078 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 62a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 78 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1967, being section 281.1078 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended and section 62a is added to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 62A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT OPERATE A VESSEL ON THE
- 5 WATERS OF THIS STATE UNLESS EACH PERSON ON BOARD THE VESSEL WHO
- 6 IS LESS THAN 7 YEARS OF AGE IS WEARING A TYPE I, TYPE II, OR TYPE
- 7 III PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE AS DESCRIBED IN R 281.1234 OF THE
- 8 MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.

- 1 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 2 MISDEMEANOR, PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90
- 3 DAYS, OR A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$100.00 OR MORE THAN \$500.00, OR
- 4 BOTH, PLUS THE COSTS OF PROSECUTION.
- 5 Sec. 78. (1) A person shall not operate on the waters of
- 6 this state a vessel having in tow or otherwise assisting a person
- 7 on water skis, water sled, aquaplane, surfboard, or other similar
- 8 contrivance, unless there is in the vessel, in EACH OF THE FOL-
- 9 LOWING CONDITIONS IS MET:
- 10 (A) IN addition to the operator, at least 1 -competent-
- 11 person -in a position CAPABLE OF RENDERING ASSISTANCE IS IN THE
- 12 VESSEL AND POSITIONED to observe the progress of the person being
- 13 towed OR ASSISTED. An observer shall be considered competent if
- 14 he can, in fact, render assistance if necessary.
- 15 All motorboats engaged in the propulsion of a person on
- 16 water skis, water sled, aquaplane, surfboard or similar contriv
- 17 ance, shall be
- (B) THE PERSON BEING TOWED OR ASSISTED IS WEARING A TYPE I,
- 19 TYPE II, OR TYPE III PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE AS DESCRIBED IN
- 20 R 281.1234 OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
- 21 (C) THE TOWING OR ASSISTING VESSEL IS equipped with a 170
- 22 degree wide angle rear view mirror affixed in a manner -as will
- 23 permit THAT PERMITS the VESSEL operator to observe the progress
- 24 of the person being towed.
- 25 (2) The provisions of this section shall SUBSECTION (1)(A)
- 26 AND (C) DO not apply to -vessels- ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- (A) A VESSEL used by duly constituted ski schools in the 2 giving of instructions, or to vessels used in sanctioned A SKI 3 SCHOOL.
- 4 (B) A VESSEL USED FOR ski tournaments, competitions, 5 expositions, or trials. therefor, or to motorboats
- (C) A MOTORBOAT less than 16 feet in length actually oper-7 ated by the person being towed and so constructed as to be 8 incapable of carrying the operator in or on the motorboat.
- 9 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1)(B) IS GUILTY OF A
  10 MISDEMEANOR, PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90
  11 DAYS, OR A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$100.00 OR MORE THAN \$500.00, OR
  12 BOTH, PLUS THE COSTS OF PROSECUTION.
