

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4772**

May 12, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Shugars and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend section 60d of Act No. 154 of the Public Acts of 1974, entitled as amended
"Michigan occupational safety and health act,"
as added by Act No. 147 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 408.1060d of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 60d of Act No. 154 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1974, as added by Act No. 147 of the Public Acts of 1986, being
- 3 section 408.1060d of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 60d. Upon request by the department, a post-abatement
- 6 air monitoring check taken pursuant to section -60b or 60c shall
- 7 be reported to the department, and after completion of the
- 8 asbestos abatement project, the level of asbestos fibers per

- I cubic centimeter of air shall not exceed 0.05 of asbestos fibers
- 2 greater than 5 micrometers in length at the asbestos abatement
- 3 project site.
- 4 Section 2. Section 60b of Act No. 154 of the Public Acts of
- 5 1974, being section 408.1060b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 8 House Bill No. 4604 of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law.
