

HOUSE BILL No. 4781

May 12, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 231 of the Public Acts of 1945, entitled

"An act to prescribe additional regulations and requirements for pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers and junk dealers; to provide for the taking of fingerprints and the making of reports to enforcement officers; to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to declare the effect of this act,"

being section 445.472 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 231 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1945, being section 445.472 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2. At the same time any pawnbroker, secondhand dealer
- 5 or junk dealer in this state shall receive any article of
- 6 personal property, or other valuable thing, by way of pledge or
- 7 pawn, or shall acquire or purchase any article of personal

- 1 property, or other valuable thing, except new articles, wares, or
- 2 merchandise purchased at wholesale from manufacturers, wholesale
- 3 distributors or jobbers for retail sale to customers, except also
- 4 motor vehicles, old rags, waste paper, books, magazines, tapes-
- 5 tries, antiques and household furniture, he OR SHE shall take -in
- 6 duplicate the legible imprint of the right thumb of the person
- 7 from whom such property was received, or if that be not possible,
- 8 of the left thumb or some other finger of such person. -Such
- 9 fingerprint shall be taken under such rules and regulations as
- 10 prescribed by the commissioner of the Michigan state police.
- 11 One A copy shall be forwarded within 48 hours, together with a
- 12 statement of the nature of the property received, to the chief of
- 13 police or chief police officer of the city in which the place of
- 14 business of such pawnbroker, secondhand dealer or junk dealer is
- 15 located, or to the sheriff of the county in case such place of
- 16 business shall be located outside the corporate limits of any
- 17 city, together with a statement of the nature of the property
- 18 received. The second copy shall be forwarded within 48 hours,
- 19 together with a statement of the nature of the property received,
- 20 to the commissioner of the Michigan state police in East
- 21 Lansing.
- 22 Section 2. Sections 3 and 4 of Act No. 231 of the Public
- 23 Acts of 1945, being sections 445.473 and 445.474 of the Michigan
- 24 Compiled Laws, are repealed.
