



HOUSE BILL No. 4844

June 10, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Kilpatrick, Wallace, Clack, Hood, Stallworth, Points, Murphy, Varga, DeLange, Munsell, Nye, Dalman, Voorhees, Horton, Crissman, Llewellyn, Brackenridge, Kukuk, Middaugh, Gnodtke, McBryde, Saunders and Cropsey and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to repeal Act No. 312 of the Public Acts of 1969,
entitled

"An act to provide for compulsory arbitration of labor disputes in municipal police and fire departments; to define such public departments; to provide for the selection of members of arbitration panels; to prescribe the procedures and authority thereof; and to provide for the enforcement and review of awards thereof,"

being sections 423.231 to 423.247 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:
