

HOUSE BILL No. 4851

June 15, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Agee, DeMars, Harrison, Willard, Anthony, Pitoniak, Murphy, Martin, Voorhees, Rhead, Porreca, Middleton, Bender, Shepich, Scott, Jacobetti, Rivers, Byrum, Stallworth, Profit and Cropsey and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 9 of the Public Acts of the First Extra Session of 1946, entitled as amended

"An act to create the Michigan veterans' trust fund, and to define who shall be eligible to receive assistance therefrom; to provide for the disbursement of the income thereof and surplus therein; to create a board of trustees, and to prescribe its powers and duties; to provide for county and district committees, and their powers, duties, and expenses; to prescribe penalties; and to make appropriations to carry out the provisions of this act,"

being section 35.604 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 9 of the Public Acts of the
- 2 First Extra Session of 1946, being section 35.604 of the Michigan
