

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4929**

July 8, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Bandstra and referred to the Committee on House Oversight and Ethics.

A bill to provide that the legislature and legislative agencies use competitive bidding when awarding contracts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- (a) "Legislative agencies" means an agency, board, bureau,
- 3 commission, council, or other entity within the legislative
- 4 branch of government of this state.
- 5 (b) "Legislature" means legislators, acting in their offi-
- 6 cial capacity, the senate, the house of representatives, and
- 7 employees of the senate and house of representatives acting in
- 8 their official capacity.
- 9 Sec. 3. Beginning January 1, 1994, all purchases and con-
- 10 tracts entered into by the legislature and legislative agencies
- 11 shall be made and awarded by competitive bidding. The
- 12 legislature and legislative agencies shall not make a purchase or

1 enter into a contract unless it has been made or awarded as
2 provided in this act.
