

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5040**

September 22, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Gire, Pitoniak, Willard, Rivers, Dobronski, Freeman, Schroer and Baade and referred to the Committee on Human Services and Children.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 250 of the Public Acts of 1982, entitled

"Child abuse and neglect prevention act,"

being section 722.604 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 250 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1982, being section 722.604 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 4. (1) The state board -shall be IS composed of the
- 5 following 15 members:
- 6 (a) The FIVE MEMBERS, | EACH APPOINTED BY THE director of
- 7 social services, the director of mental health, the director of
- 8 public health, the superintendent of public instruction, and the
- 9 director of the department of state police. , or designees
- 10 authorized to speak on their behalf. A MEMBER APPOINTED UNDER

- 1 THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT BE A STATE EMPLOYEE AND SHALL
- 2 REPRESENT THE AREA OF INTEREST OF THE RESPECTIVE APPOINTING
- 3 OFFICER'S DEPARTMENT.
- 4 (b) Ten public members appointed by the governor with the
- 5 advice and consent of the senate. As a group, the -public mem-
- 6 bers APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION shall demonstrate knowledge
- 7 in the area of child abuse and neglect prevention; shall be rep-
- 8 resentative of the demographic composition of this state; and, to
- 9 the extent practicable, shall be representative of all of the
- 10 following categories: parents, organized labor, the business
- 11 community, the religious community, the legal community, profes-
- 12 sional providers of child abuse and neglect prevention services,
- 13 and volunteers in child abuse and neglect prevention services.
- 14 (2) The term of each -public member shall be 3 years. -
- 15 except that of the public members first appointed, 3 shall serve
- 16 for 3 years, 3 for 2 years, and 4 for 1 year. A public member
- 17 shall not serve more than 2 consecutive terms whether partial or
- 18 full. A vacancy shall be filled for the balance of the unexpired
- 19 term in the same manner as the original appointment.
- 20 (3) The governor shall designate a chairperson of the state
- 21 board from among the -public members APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 22 (1)(B), which chairperson shall serve in that position at the
- 23 pleasure of the governor. The state board may elect other offi-
- 24 cers and committees as it considers appropriate.
- 25 (4) The actual and necessary per diem compensation and the
- 26 schedule for reimbursement of expenses for the -public members
- 27 of the state board shall be the same as is established annually

- I by the legislature for similar boards that are reimbursed from
- 2 the general fund. The compensation and reimbursement, executive
- 3 director and staff salaries, and all actual and necessary operat-
- 4 ing expenses of the state board shall be paid from the trust
- 5 fund, pursuant to an authorization as provided in section 9.
