

HOUSE BILL No. 5087

October 12, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Rocca, Vorva, Galloway, Kukuk, McNutt, Freeman, Cropsey, LeTarte, Curtis, Kaza and Jaye and referred to the Committee on Corrections.

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 118 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled

"The prisoner reimbursement to the county act," being section 801.83 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 118 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1984, being section 801.83 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) The county may seek reimbursement for any
- 5 expenses incurred by the county in relation to the charge or
- 6 charges for which a person was sentenced to a county jail as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) From each person who is or was a prisoner, not more than
- 9 \$30.00 per day for the expenses of maintaining that prisoner or
- 10 the actual per diem cost of maintaining that prisoner -

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- 1 whichever is less, for the entire period of time the person was
- 2 confined in the county jail, including any period of pretrial
- 3 detention.
- 4 (b) To investigate the financial status of the person.
- 5 (c) Any other expenses incurred by the county in order to6 collect payments under this act.
- 7 (2) Before seeking any reimbursement under this act, the
- 8 county shall develop a form to be used for the determining the
- 9 financial status of prisoners. The form shall provide for
- 10 obtaining the age and marital status of a prisoner, the number
- 11 and ages of children of a prisoner, -the number and ages of
- 12 other dependents, type and value of real estate, type and value
- 13 of personal property, cash and bank accounts, type and value of
- 14 investments, pensions and annuities, and any other personalty of
- 15 significant cash value. The county shall use the form when
- 16 investigating the financial status of prisoners.
