



HOUSE BILL No. 5201

November 16, 1993, Introduced by Reps. Rhead, London and Llewellyn and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 695 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended "Michigan vehicle code," as amended by Act No. 90 of the Public Acts of 1987, being section 257.695 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 695 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
2 1949, as amended by Act No. 90 of the Public Acts of 1987, being
3 section 257.695 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 695. (1) All vehicles, including ~~animal drawn~~
6 ~~vehicles~~, implements of husbandry, road machinery, road rollers,
7 and farm tractors, not otherwise required under this act to be
8 equipped with head or rear lamps, shall at the times specified in
9 section 684 be equipped with at least 1 lighted lamp or lantern

1 exhibiting a white light visible from a distance of 500 feet to
2 the front of the vehicle and with a lamp or lantern exhibiting a
3 red light visible from a distance of 300 feet to the rear of the
4 vehicle.

5 (2) AN ANIMAL-DRAWN VEHICLE BEING DRIVEN UPON A ROADWAY
6 SHALL AT THE TIMES SPECIFIED IN SECTION 684 BE EQUIPPED WITH AT
7 LEAST 1 LAMP EXHIBITING A FLASHING WHITE OR AMBER LIGHT VISIBLE
8 FROM A DISTANCE OF 500 FEET TO THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE AND WITH
9 AT LEAST 1 LAMP EXHIBITING A FLASHING AMBER OR RED LIGHT VISIBLE
10 FROM A DISTANCE OF 300 FEET TO THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE.
