

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5348**

February 16, 1994 Introduced by Rep Gagliardi and referred to the Committee on Judiciary

A bill to create a legislative criminal justice data and analysis center to provide for the appointment of a director of the center and prescribe the director's powers and duties and to prescribe certain powers and duties of the legislative council

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Sec 1 As used in this act
- 2 (a) "Center' means the legislative criminal justice data and 3 analysis center created in section 2
- 4 (b) 'Director" means the director of the center appointed
  5 under section 2
- 6 (c) "Legislative council" means that body established under
- 7 section 15 of article IV of the state constitution of 1963
- Sec 2 (1) A legislative criminal justice data and
- 9 analysis center is created within the legislative council

- 1 (2) The principal executive officer of the center is the
- 2 director who shall be appointed by the legislative council and
- 3 shall serve at the pleasure of the legislative council
- 4 (3) The legislative council shall establish procedures for
- 5 approving the budget of the center, for expending the funds of
- 6 the center, and for the employment of personnel for the center
- 7 Sec 3 (1) The center shall conduct research and analysis
- 8 on all of the following issues as to this state
- 9 (a) Crimes committed by adults or juveniles, and trends in
- 10 the types and number of crimes committed
- (b) State and local law enforcement efforts and needs
- (c) The functions and operations of the judiciary and
- 13 prosecution
- (d) The incidence of child abuse and neglect and its rela-
- 15 tionship to the incidence of juvenile delinquency and the inci-
- 16 dence of crimes committed by adults
- (e) The incidence of drug abuse and its relationship to the
- 18 incidence of crimes
- (f) The juvenile and adult corrections systems and the
- 20 projected increases or decreases in the number of persons incar-
- 21 cerated or detained within those corrections systems, and the
- 22 relationship of that number of persons to existing and planned
- 23 capacity of those corrections systems
- 24 (g) Prosecutorial charging and plea bargaining practices
- 25 (2) The director may access the law enforcement information
- 26 network to obtain information about crimes for purposes of this
- 27 act

- 1 Sec 4 The director shall maintain as part of the center a
- 2 statewide jail data base The statewide jail data base shall
- 3 contain current data on all of the following issues regarding the
- 4 operation of county jails in this state
- 5 (a) The population of inmates housed in jails, and projected
- 6 increases or decreases in that population, and the relationship
- 7 of that number of persons to existing and planned capacity of the
- 8 corrections system
- 9 (b) The cost of maintaining and operating jails
- 10 (c) The status of inmates housed in pails, including the
- 11 number of inmates who are awaiting trial and the reason for which
- 12 they are in jail awaiting trial, and the number of inmates who
- 13 are serving sentences of imprisonment
- (d) The types of offenses for which persons are committed to
- 15 jails, and the projected trends in the types of offenses
- (e) The inmate classification systems utilized by jails
- (f) Other issues considered by the director to be relevant
- 18 to the purposes of the statewide jail data base
- 19 Sec 5 The director shall report quarterly to the legisla-
- 20 tive council as to the issues on which the center conducts
- 21 research and analysis, including the statewide jail data base
- 22 The director also shall report annually to the legislative coun-
- 23 cil on the conduct of the center Copies of the annual report
- 24 shall be submitted to the state court administrator and the
- 25 directors of the departments of corrections, management and
- 26 budget, and state police
