A bill to amend sections 681 and 682 of Act No 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

The school code of 1976

section 681 as amended by Act No 21 of the Public Acts of 1984 being sections 380 681 and 380 682 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Sections 681 and 682 of Act No 451 of the
2 Public Acts of 1976 section 681 as amended by Act No 21 of the
3 Public Acts of 1984 being sections 380 681 and 380 682 of the
4 Michigan Compiled Laws are amended to read as follows
5 Sec 681 (1) An intermediate school district may establish
6 an area vocational-technical education program and operate the
7 program under sections 681 to 690 if approved by a majority of
8 the INTERMEDIATE school electors of the intermediate school

1 district voting on the question The election shall be called
 2 and conducted pursuant to sections 661 and 662 The establish-
 3 ment of the area vocational-technical education program may be
 4 rescinded by the same process

5 (2) The question of establishing an area
 6 vocational-technical education program may be submitted to the
 7 INTERMEDIATE school electors of an intermediate school district
 8 at an annual election or at a special election held in each of
 9 the constituent districts The intermediate school board shall
 10 determine the date of the election and shall give notice under
 11 section 662 to the secretary of each constituent district at
 12 least 60 days in advance of the date the proposition is to be
 13 submitted to the INTERMEDIATE school electors

14 (3) The ballot for referring the question of adopting sec-
 15 tions 681 to 690 and establishing an area vocational-technical
 16 education program to the INTERMEDIATE school electors of an
 17 intermediate school district shall be substantially in the fol-
 18 lowing form
