

HOUSE BILL No. 5449

A bill to amend section 5a of Act No 181 of the Public Acts of 1953 entitled as amended

An act relative to investigations in certain instances of the causes of death within this state due to violence negligence or other act or omission of a criminal nature or to protect public health to provide for the taking of statements from injured persons under certain circumstances to abolish the office of coroner and to create the office of county medical examiner in certain counties to prescribe the powers and duties of county medical examiners to prescribe penalties for violations of the provisions of this act and to prescribe a referendum thereon,

being section 52 205a of the Michigan Compiled Laws

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Section 1 Section 5a of Act No 181 of the Public Acts of

- 3 amended to read as follows
- 4 Sec 5a (1) When IF a child PERSON under the age of 2
- 5 years dies within this state under circumstances of sudden

- 1 death cause unknown INDICATING THAT THE DEATH MAY HAVE BEEN
- 2 CAUSED BY ACCIDENTAL ASPHYXIATION OR SUDDEN INFANT DEATH
- 3 SYNDROME or IS found dead FROM UNKNOWN CAUSES -cause unknown,
- 4 that death shall be immediately reported to the county medical
- 5 examiner of the county -wherein IN WHICH the body lies -

- 15 examiner SHALL CONDUCT THE AUTOPSY OR ORDER THE AUTOPSY TO BE
- 16 CONDUCTED, and the parents or legal guardians shall be promptly

- 7 (4) IF A COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER DETERMINES AS A RESULT OF
- 8 AN AUTOPSY CONDUCTED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) THAT THE CAUSE OF DEATH
- 9 WAS ACCIDENTAL ASPHYXIATION, THE COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER SHALL
- 10 INCLUDE SUDDEN INFANT DEATH SYNDROME IN THE AUTOPSY REPORT AS A
- 11 POSSIBLE ALTERNATIVE CAUSE OF DEATH
