A bill to amend section 1066 of Act No 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

- 17 retary of the board shall canvass the petitions to ascertain if
- 18 the petitions have been signed by the requisite number of regis-
- 19 tered school electors , and for the purpose of determining
- 20 their validity TO DETERMINE THE VALIDITY OF NOMINATING PETI-
- 21 TIONS, THE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD may check doubtful signatures
- 22 against the registration records MAINTAINED by the clerk of the
- 23 political subdivision in which each petition was circulated to
- 24 determine the authenticity of the signatures If -it-is

- 5 secretary of the board shall IMMEDIATELY notify the candidate

- 7 secretary of the board, the treasurer of the board shall perform

- 10 behalf of a proposed candidate for membership on the board, the
- 11 PROPOSED candidate shall not be permitted to withdraw unless
- 12 -a- written notice of withdrawal, signed by the candidate, is
- 13 served on the secretary of the board or an authorized agent of
- 14 the secretary of the board not later than 4 p m of the third
- 15 day after the last day for filing -the petition NOMINATING
- 16 PETITIONS The secretary of the board shall notify the county
- 17 clerk of the names and addresses of the candidates not later than
- 18 3 days after the last date for candidate withdrawal However, if
- 19 the third day is a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the notice
- 20 may be made on the next -secular BUSINESS day
