



# HOUSE BILL No. 5463

April 19 1994 Introduced by Reps Oxender and Gilmer and referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A bill to amend section 111 of Act No 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended

"The state school aid act of 1979,"

as amended by Act No 336 of the Public Acts of 1993, being section 388 1711 of the Michigan Compiled Laws and to add section 21d

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Section 111 of Act No 94 of the Public Acts of  
2 1979, as amended by Act No 336 of the Public Acts of 1993, being  
3 section 388 1711 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and  
4 section 21d is added to read as follows

5 SEC 21D FROM THE APPROPRIATION IN SECTION 11, THERE IS  
6 ALLOCATED FOR 1994-95 AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$0 00 FOR  
7 REORGANIZATION PLANNING GRANTS AND CERTAIN OTHER PURPOSES  
8 APPLICATIONS FOR REORGANIZATION PLANNING GRANTS SHALL BE

1 SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT IN THE FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY  
2 THE DEPARTMENT A REORGANIZATION PLANNING GRANT SHALL NOT EXCEED  
3 \$0 00

4 Sec 111 (1) Except as provided in section 113, a district  
5 having tuition pupils enrolled on the pupil membership count day  
6 of each year shall charge the district in which the tuition  
7 pupils reside the tuition rate computed under section 1401 of the  
8 school code of 1976, being section 380 1401 of the Michigan  
9 Compiled Laws The resulting tuition rates shall be reduced by  
10 the district's foundation allowance provided under section 20,  
11 except that a district shall charge the full per capita operating  
12 cost determined under section 1401 of the school code of 1976 for  
13 tuition pupils other than special education pupils served in  
14 center programs if the district enrolls pupils, other than spe-  
15 cial education pupils, who reside in a district that is legally  
16 liable for the payment of the tuition and that ~~levies~~ HAS a  
17 lower ~~operating millage~~ FOUNDATION ALLOWANCE than the district  
18 enrolling the pupils

19 (2) A pupil for whom the full per capita operating cost, as  
20 determined under section 1401 of the school code of 1976, is  
21 charged as tuition under subsection (1) shall not be counted in  
22 membership in the receiving district for purposes of calculating  
23 that district's foundation allowance under section 20 A pupil  
24 for whom the full per capita operating cost, as determined under  
25 section 1401 of the school code of 1976 is paid by the pupil's  
26 district of residence under subsection (1) shall be counted in  
27 membership in the pupil's district of residence solely for

1 purposes of calculating that district s foundation allowance  
2 under section 20

3 (3) An additional allowance for nonpublic, nonresident  
4 pupils in part-time membership shall be made to the district  
5 receiving nonpublic, nonresident pupils in an amount equal to the  
6 difference between the per capita cost as determined under sec-  
7 tion 1401 of the school code of 1976 and the district s founda-  
8 tion allowance calculated under section 20

9 (4) The secretary of the board of each district enrolling  
10 nonresident pupils shall certify to the department on forms fur-  
11 nished by the department, the number of nonresident pupils  
12 enrolled in each grade on the pupil membership count day of each  
13 year, the districts in which the nonresident pupils reside, the  
14 amount of tuition charged for the current year, and other infor-  
15 mation required by the department

16 Section 2 This amendatory act shall take effect October 1,
