



HOUSE BILL No. 5491

April 21 1994 Introduced by Reps Agee Rivers Saunders Schroer Points Pitoniak and LeTarte and referred to the Committee on Judiciary

A bill to amend section 14 of Act No 372 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license to provide for the forfeiture of firearms possessed in violation of this act to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act,

being section 28 434 of the Michigan Compiled Laws and to repeal certain parts of the act

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Section 14 of Act No 372 of the Public Acts of
2 1927, being section 28 434 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows

4 Sec 14 (1) All pistols, weapons, or devices carried or
5 possessed contrary to this act are ~~hereby declared~~ forfeited to

1 the state ~~and~~ and WHEN NO LONGER NEEDED AS EVIDENCE shall be
2 turned over to the ~~commissioner~~ DIRECTOR of the ~~Michigan~~
3 DEPARTMENT OF state police or his OR HER designated
4 representative ~~for such disposition as said commissioner may~~
5 ~~prescribe~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE DEPARTMENT
6 SHALL DESTROY THOSE PISTOLS, WEAPONS, OR DEVICES

7 (2) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE OR HIS OR
8 HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE MAY EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF
9 SUBSECTION (1) ANY FIREARM TO BE USED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
10 OF THIS STATE OR ANY WEAPON TO BE USED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE
11 POLICE CRIME LABORATORY OR INTENDED FOR DISPLAY IN AN HISTORICAL
12 MUSEUM

13 Section 2 Section 9d of Act No 372 of the Public Acts of
14 1927 being section 28 429d of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
15 repealed
