A bill to amend sections 6 and 1071 of Act No 451 of the Public Acts of 1976 entitled as amended

'The school code of 1976,

section 6 as amended by Act No 159 of the Public Acts of 1989, being sections 380 6 and 380 1071 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Sections 6 and 1071 of Act No 451 of the Public
2 Acts of 1976, section 6 as amended by Act No 159 of the Public
3 Acts of 1989, being sections 380 6 and 380 1071 of the Michigan
4 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows

5 Sec 6 (1) "School bus" means a motor vehicle, other than
6 a station wagon or passenger van, with a manufacturer's rated
7 seating capacity of 17 or more pupils used for the transportation
8 of school pupils to and from school ~~which~~ THAT either is owned
9 by a school district or, if privately owned, is transporting

1 school pupils under a contract with a local school district, a
 2 local act school district, or an intermediate school district
 3 As used in this subsection

4 (a) "Passenger van" means a motor vehicle designed to carry
 5 not more than 16 passengers, built on a truck chassis, and regis-
 6 tered and titled by the secretary of state as a station wagon

7 (b) "Station wagon" means a motor vehicle designed to carry
 8 not more than 10 passengers and built on a passenger vehicle
 9 chassis

10 (2) "School district or local school district means

11 (a) A primary school district

12 (b) A school district of the fourth class

13 (c) A school district of the third class

14 (d) A school district of the second class

15 (e) A school district of the first class

16 (3) "School elector" means a person ~~qualified as an elector~~

17 ~~under section 492~~ WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 493 of
 18 the Michigan election law, Act No 116 of the Public Acts of
 19 1954, as amended, being section ~~168-492~~ 168 493 of the Michigan
 20 Compiled Laws, and resident of the school district, local act
 21 school district, or intermediate school district on or before the
 22 thirtieth day before the next ensuing annual or special school
 23 election

24 (4) "School month" means a 4-week period of 5 days each
 25 unless otherwise specified in the teacher's contract

26 (5) "Special education building and equipment" means a
 27 structure or portion of a structure or personal property

1 accepted, leased, purchased, or otherwise acquired, prepared, or
2 used for special education programs and services

3 (6) Special education personnel means persons engaged in
4 and having professional responsibility for the training, care,
5 and education of handicapped persons in special education pro-
6 grams and services including, but not limited to teachers,
7 aides, social workers, diagnostic personnel physical therapists,
8 occupational therapists, audiologists, teachers of speech and
9 language, instructional media-curriculum specialists, mobility
10 specialists, teacher consultants, supervisors, and directors

11 (7) 'Special education programs and services means educa-
12 tional and training services designed for handicappers and oper-
13 ated by local school districts, local act school districts,
14 intermediate school districts, the Michigan school for the blind,
15 the Michigan school for the deaf, the department of mental
16 health, the department of social services, or a combination
17 thereof and ancillary professional services for handicappers
18 rendered by agencies approved by the state board The programs
19 shall include vocational training but need not include academic
20 programs of college or university level

21 (8) "State approved nonpublic school means a nonpublic
22 school that complies with Act No 302 of the Public Acts of 1921,
23 as amended, being sections 388 551 to 388 558 of the Michigan
24 Compiled Laws

25 (9) "State board' means the state board of education unless
26 clearly otherwise stated

1 (10) Department means the department of education created
2 and operating under sections 300 to 305 of the executive
3 organization act of 1965, Act No 380 of the Public Acts of 1965
4 being sections 16 400 to 16 405 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

5 (11) State school aid' means allotments from the general
6 appropriating act for the purpose of aiding in the support of the
7 public schools of ~~the~~ THIS state

8 (12) 'The state school aid act of 1979" means Act No 94 of
9 the Public Acts of 1979, being sections 388 1601 to 388 1772 of
10 the Michigan Compiled Laws

11 (13) 'Type I school bus" means a school bus with a gross
12 vehicle weight rating of more than 10 000 pounds

13 (14) 'Type II school bus means a school bus with a gross
14 vehicle rating of 10,000 pounds or less

15 (15) "Type I premium school bus' means a school bus with a
16 passenger capacity of more than 66 pupils and any other school
17 bus purchased by a district at a cost for the vehicle excluding
18 interest and special equipment, that exceeds by more than 15% the
19 average cost of a school bus meeting state minimum specifications
20 of the same capacity purchased during the same year

21 Sec 1071 THE MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW, Act No 116 of the
22 Public Acts of 1954, as amended, being sections 168 1 to 168 992
