A bill to create the Michigan national guard scholarship grant program to provide financial and for certain individuals at certain Michigan colleges and universities, to prescribe certain powers and duties of certain state agencies, and for related purposes

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Sec 1 This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "Michigan national guard scholarship act"
- 3 Sec 2 As used in this act
- 4 (a) "Authority" means the Michigan higher education assist-
- 5 ance authority created by Act No 77 of the Public Acts of 1960,
- 6 being sections 390 951 to 390 961 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

- (b) "Grant" means a first-year Michigan national guard
   scholarship grant or a renewal of a Michigan national guard
   scholarship grant
- 4 (c) "Michigan college or university" means a state univer5 sity described in section 4, 5, or 6 of article VIII of the state
  6 constitution of 1963 a community or junior college established
  7 under section 7 of article VIII of the state constitution of 1963
  8 or part 25 of the school code of 1976, Act No 451 of the Public
  9 Acts of 1976, being sections 380 1601 to 380 1607 of the Michigan
  10 Compiled Laws, or a regionally or nationally accredited nonprofit
  11 independent degree-granting college or university that is located
- (d) "Tuition" means the tuition and mandatory fees charged
   by a Michigan college or university to a Michigan resident
   Sec 3 (1) The Michigan national quard scholarship program

- 17 (2) The authority shall do all of the following
- (a) Determine the eligibility of grant applicants
- (b) Pay to Michigan colleges and universities on behalf of
- 20 grant recipients the difference between the grant recipient's

- 9 (c) Promulgate rules it considers necessary for the adminis-
- 10 tration of this act The rules shall be promulgated under the
- 11 administrative procedures act of 1969, Act No 306 of the Public
- 12 Acts of 1969, being sections 24 201 to 24 328 of the Michigan
- 13 Compiled Laws
- 14 (3) The authority may accept gifts, grants, bequests, dona-
- 15 tions, devises, and other contributions from any source of money
- 16 or other real, personal, or mixed property for the purposes of
- 17 this act The authority shall prepare and submit an annual
- 18 report to the legislature detailing the contributions received
- 19 under this subsection
- 20 Sec 4 (1) An individual is eligible to receive a
- 21 first-year Michigan national guard scholarship grant under this
- 22 act if he or she is determined by the authority to meet all of
- 23 the following requirements
- 24 (a) Has resided continuously in this state for the 12 months
- 25 immediately preceding his or her application and is not consid-
- 26 ered a resident of any other state

- (c) For an individual qualifying under subsection (!)(g)(11)

  2 as a surviving child, until the end of the semester or term in

  3 which the individual's twenty-fifth birthday occurs, but not

  4 after completing the degree requirements for a bachelor's

  5 degree
- 6 Sec 5 Upon application, the adjutant general of the
  7 Michigan national guard or his or her designee shall issue cer8 tificates of eligibility to individuals he or she determines to
  9 meet the requirements specified in section 4(1)(g) or 4(2)(b)
  10 Sec 6 (1) If a member of the Michigan national guard
  11 receiving a grant under this act voluntarily withdraws from a
  12 course for which he or she has received the grant and the author13 ity does not receive a refund from the Michigan college or uni14 versity, the member shall reimburse the authority for the amount
  15 of the grant attributable to that course

(2) If a member of the Michigan national quard receiving a

17 grant under this act fails to complete his or her term of enlist18 ment for a reason other than death or disability, the member
19 shall reimburse the authority for the amount of that grant
20 (3) If a member of the Michigan national guard receiving a
21 grant under this act becomes obligated under subsection (1) or
22 (2) to reimburse the authority for the amount of the grant he or
23 she received, the grant he or she received becomes a loan repay24 able to the authority at the same interest rate and on the same
25 terms and conditions as a loan guaranteed by the authority under
26 Act No 77 of the Public Acts of 1960, being sections 390 951 to
27 390 961 of the Michigan Compiled Laws The authority shall

- 2 repayment of a loan guaranteed by the authority under Act No 77
