## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- 1 Section 1 Act No 331 of the Public Acts of 1976 as
- 2 amended being sections 445 901 to 445 922 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws is amended by adding section lia to read as
- 4 follows
- 5 SEC 11A (1) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTIES OR REME-
- 6 DIES PROVIDED BY THIS ACT IF A PERSON IS FOUND TO HAVE VIOLATED
- 7 THIS ACT AND THE VIOLATION WAS COMMITTED AGAINST AN ELDER OR
- 8 DISABLED PERSON THEN THE PERSON SHALL BE ASSESSED BY THE COURT A
- 9 CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10 000 00 FOR EACH VIOLATION ANY

- I FINES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN
- 2 THE STATE TREASURY AND CREDITED TO THE ELDER AND DISABLED VICTIMS

- 6 (3) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A
- 7 STATEWIDE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO INFORM ELDER PERSONS AND DIS-
- 8 ABLED PERSONS, LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM
- 9 SOCIAL SERVICES PROFESSIONALS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC AS TO THE
- 10 PREVAILNCE AND PREVENTION OF CONSUMER CRIMES AGAINST ELDER AND
- 11 DISABLED PERSONS THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT AND THE PENALTIES
- 12 FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT AND THE REMEDIES AVAILABLE FOR VICTIMS
- 13 OF VIOLATIONS
- (4) THE ELDER AND DISABLED VICTIMS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN
- 15 THL STATE TREASURY
- 16 (5) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
- 17 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND THE STATE TREASURER
- 18 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND THE STATE TREASURER
- 19 SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND
- 20 INVESTMENTS THE STATE TREASURER SHALL ANNUALLY PRESENT TO THE
- 21 DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL AN ACCOUNTING OF THE AMOUNT OF
- 22 MONEY IN THE FUND
- 23 (6) MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL
- 24 REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND
- 25 (7) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE FUND
- 26 FOR THE INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION OF VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT
