



# HOUSE BILL No. 5603

June 1 1994 Introduced by Rep Olshove and referred to the Committee on Judiciary

A bill to amend Act No 328 of the Public Acts of 1931,  
entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750 1 to 750 568 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 216b

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Act No 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as  
2 amended being sections 750 1 to 750 568 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 216b to read as follows

4 SEC 216B (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT A PEACE OFFICER  
5 SHALL NOT DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING

6 (A) INFORM ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL THAT HE OR SHE IS A PEACE  
7 OFFICER IN ORDER TO COMMIT OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME

1 (B) REPRESENT TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL BY UNIFORM, BADGE,  
2 IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR ANY OTHER MEANS THAT HE OR SHE IS A PEACE  
3 OFFICER IN ORDER TO COMMIT OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME

4 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IN ORDER TO  
5 COMMIT OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND  
6 SHALL BE PUNISHED BY IMPRISONMENT FOR 2 YEARS

7 (3) A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT PRESCRIBED UNDER THIS SECTION IS  
8 IN ADDITION TO THE SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR THE CONVICTION OF THE  
9 CRIME OR THE ATTEMPT TO COMMIT THE CRIME AND SHALL BE SERVED CON-  
10 SECUTIVELY TO ANY TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED FOR THE CONVICTION  
11 OF THE CRIME OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT THE CRIME

12 (4) A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL  
13 NOT BE SUSPENDED THE INDIVIDUAL SUBJECT TO THE SENTENCE MAN-  
14 DATED UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PAROLE OR PROBATION  
15 DURING THE MANDATORY TERM

16 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PEACE OFFICER" MEANS 1 OR MORE  
17 OF THE FOLLOWING

18 (A) A POLICE OR CONSERVATION OFFICER OF THIS STATE OR OF A  
19 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE

20 (B) A POLICE OR CONSERVATION OFFICER OF THE UNITED STATES

21 (C) A POLICE OR CONSERVATION OFFICER OF ANOTHER STATE OR OF  
22 A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF ANOTHER STATE
