A bill to amend section 7a of Act No 94 of the Public Acts of 1925, entitled as amended

"Commercial forest act,'

as added by Act No 393 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 320 307a of the Michigan Compiled Laws

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- Section 1 Section 7a of Act No 94 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1925 as added by Act No 393 of the Public Acts of 1980, being

- 4 read as follows
- 5 Sec 7a (1) If, and for the period which, the state

- 1 state school aid to account for the receipt of revenues provided
- 2 under this act in place of exempted ad valorem property tax, rev
- 3 enues required pursuant to subsection (2) to be remitted or
- 4 returned to the state treasury to the credit of the state school

- 6 districts BEGINNING IN 1994, TO DETERMINE THE PROPORTION FOR

- 13 (2) Beginning with levies or payments of the following rev
- 14 enues after the effective date of this section, in 1994, THE
- 15 SPECIFIC TAXES COLLECTED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS
- 16 FOLLOWS
- 17 (A) IN the case of <del>local and</del> ntermediate school districts
- 18 receiving state aid under sections -21, 27, 56 62, and 81 of
- 19 Act No 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, as amended, being sec-
- 20 tions 388 1621, 388 1627, 388 1656, 388 1662, and 388 1681 of
- 21 the Michigan Compiled Laws, all or a portion of the amount that
- 22 would otherwise be disbursed to these INTERMEDIATE school dis-
- 23 tricts from the following revenue sources, as determined pursuant
- 24 to a formula prescribed by the department of management and
- 25 budget on the basis of the tax rate utilized to compute the
- 26 amount of state and for the INTERMEDIATE school district, shall
- 27 be paid instead to the state treasury to the credit of the state

- 12 (B) THE AMOUNT TO BE DISBURSED TO A LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT,
- 13 EXCEPT FOR THAT AMOUNT OF TAX ATTRIBUTABLE TO MILLS LEVIED UNDER
- 14 SECTION 1211C OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976, ACT NO 451 OF THE
- 15 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1976, BEING SECTION 380 1211C OF THE MICHIGAN
- 16 COMPILED LAWS, AND SUPPLEMENTAL PROPERTY TAXES AND MILLS THAT ARE
- 17 NOT INCLUDED AS MILLS LEVIED FOR SCHOOL OPERATING PURPOSES UNDER
- 18 SECTION 1211 OF ACT NO 451 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1976 BEING
- 19 SECTION 380 1211 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS SHALL BE PAID TO
- 20 THE STATE TREASURY AND CREDITED TO THE STATE SCHOOL AID FUND
- 21 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 11 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION
