A bill to amend section 7a of Act No 94 of the Public Acts of 1925, entitled as amended
"Commercial forest act,"
as added by Act No 393 of the Public Acts of 1980, being section 320 307a of the Michigan Compiled Laws

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

17 (A) IN the case of ~~local and~~ ntermediate school districts

 26 amount of state aid for the INTERMEDIATE school district, shall
 27 be paid instead to the state treasury to the credit of the state

8 (3) ~~(c)~~ Revenues from remitted withdrawal penalties and
9 fees imposed pursuant to section 7

10 (4) ~~(d)~~ Revenues from remitted stumpage or yield tax col-
11 lections made pursuant to section 9

12 (B) THE AMOUNT TO BE DISBURSED TO A LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT,
13 EXCEPT FOR THAT AMOUNT OF TAX ATTRIBUTABLE TO MILLS LEVIED UNDER
14 SECTION 1211C OF THE SCHOOL CODE OF 1976, ACT NO 451 OF THE
15 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1976, BEING SECTION 380 1211C OF THE MICHIGAN
16 COMPILED LAWS, AND SUPPLEMENTAL PROPERTY TAXES AND MILLS THAT ARE
17 NOT INCLUDED AS MILLS LEVIED FOR SCHOOL OPERATING PURPOSES UNDER
18 SECTION 1211 OF ACT NO 451 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1976 BEING
19 SECTION 380 1211 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS SHALL BE PAID TO
20 THE STATE TREASURY AND CREDITED TO THE STATE SCHOOL AID FUND
21 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 11 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION
