A bill to amend section 8122 of Act No 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
as amended by Act No 135 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 600 8122 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and to add section 9938a

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

- Section 1 Section 8122 of Act No 236 of the Public Acts

- 4 and section 9938a is added to read as follows
- 5 Sec 8122 (1) The thirty-seventh district consists of the
- 6 cities of Warren and Center Line, is a district of the third
- 7 class, and has 4 judges

- 7 additional judge effective January 1, 1989 If a new office of

- 20 of Macomb, is a district of the third class, and has $\frac{2}{3}$
- 21 judges Subject to section 8175, this district may have 1 addi-
- 22 tional judge effective January 1, 1989 If a new office of judge
- 23 is added to this district to be filled by election in 1988, the
- 24 term of office of the judge for that election only shall be 4
- 25 years
- 26 (7) The forty-second district consists of the cities of
- 27 Memphis, Richmond, and New Baltimore and the townships of Bruce,

- 1 Washington, Armada, Ray, Richmond, Lenox, and Chesterfield in the
- 2 county of Macomb, is a district of the second class and is
- 3 divided into the following election divisions
- 4 (a) The first division consists of the cities of Memphis and
- 5 Richmond and the townships of Bruce, Washington, Armada, Ray, and
- 6 Richmond and has 1 judge
- 7 (b) The second division consists of the city of New
- 8 Baltimore and the townships of Lenox and Chesterfield and has 1
- 9 judge
- 10 SEC 9938A EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1996, THE DISTRICT COURT
- 11 SHALL COMMENCE TO FUNCTION IN THE THIRTY-EIGHTH DISTRICT AND, AS
- 12 OF THAT DATE, THE MUNICIPAL COURT WITHIN THAT DISTRICT IS
- 13 ABOLISHED THE DISTRICT JUDGE PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 8122(2)
- 14 SHALL BE ELECTED AT A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD FOR THAT PURPOSE, AND
- 15 SHALL TAKE OFFICE ON JANUARY 1, 1996
- 16 Section 2 If a district judge is elected in the
- 17 thirty-eighth district for a term beginning January 1, 1996, as
- 18 authorized by this amendatory act, that term shall end January 1,
- 19 2001 This section applies only to the term specified in this
- 20 section
