

HOUSE BILL No. 5800

September 14 1994, Introduced by Reps Cropsey, McNutt, LeTarte Weeks Freeman, Clack, Schroer, Lowe, Pitoniak and Galloway and referred to the Committee on Corrections

A bill to amend section 63a of Act No 232 of the Public Acts of 1953 entitled

An act to revise, consolidate, and codify the laws relating to probationers and probation officers, to pardons, reprieves commutations and paroles to the administration of correctional institutions correctional farms, and probation recovery camps to prisoner labor and correctional industries, and to the supervision and inspection of local jails and houses of correction to provide for the siting of correctional facilities to create a state department of corrections and to prescribe its powers and duties to provide for the transfer to and vesting in said department of powers and duties vested by law in certain other state boards commissions, and officers and to abolish certain commissions and offices the powers and duties of which are transferred by this act to prescribe the powers and duties of certain other state departments and agencies to provide for the creation of a local lockup advisory board to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act to make certain appropriations to repeal certain parts of this act on specific dates and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act

being section 791 263a of the Michigan Compiled Laws
