- 5 (2) The fees prescribed in subsection (1) , no part of
- 6 which shall be refunded, shall be ARE NOT REFUNDABLE UNLESS THE
- 7 ADMINISTRATOR FAILS TO ENDORSE THE DOCUMENT AS PROVIDED IN SEC-
- 8 TION 131 AND ARE in addition to the franchise fees prescribed in
- 9 this act -, and shall, when collected, THE FEES COLLECTED UNDER
- 10 THIS ACT SHALL be paid into the treasury of the state and cred-
- 11 ited to the administrator to be used solely by the corporation
- 12 and securities bureau in carrying out those duties required by
- 13 law
- 14 (3) Fees paid by or on behalf of domestic and foreign requ-
- 15 lated investment companies as defined in section 1064 shall be
- 16 the same as are charged foreign and domestic corporations for the
- 17 purposes specified in this section
- 18 (4) The fees received pursuant to section 915 shall be
- 19 deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the administra-
- 20 tor to be used by the corporation and securities bureau in carry-
- 21 ing out those duties required by law After the payment of the
- 22 amounts appropriated by the legislature for the necessary
- 23 expenses incurred in the administration of this act, the money
- 24 remaining shall be credited to the general fund of the state
- 25 (5) A minimum charge of \$1 00 for each certificate and 50
- 26 cents per folio shall be paid to the administrator for certifying
- 27 a part of a file or record pertaining to a corporation for which

- 1 provision for payment is not set forth in subsection (1) The
- 2 administrator may furnish copies of documents, reports, and
- 3 papers required or permitted by law to be filed with the adminis-
- 4 trator, and shall charge for those copies pursuant to a schedule
- 5 of fees which the administrator shall adopt with the approval of
- 6 the state administrative board The administrator shall retain
- 7 the revenue collected under this subsection to be used by the
- 8 corporation and securities bureau to defray the costs for its
- 9 copying and certifying services
- (6) If a domestic or foreign corporation pays fees or penal-
- 11 ties by check and the check is dishonored the fee shall be con-
- 12 sidered unpaid and the filing of all related documents will be
- 13 rescinded
- 14 (7) The administrator may accept a credit card in lieu of
- 15 cash or check, as payment of a fee under this act The adminis-
- 16 trator shall determine which credit cards may be accepted for
- 17 payment
- 18 (8) The administrator may charge a nonretundable fee of up
- 19 to \$50 00 for any document submitted or certificate sent by fac-
- 20 simile transmission The administrator shall retain the revenue
- 21 collected under this section to be used by the corporation and
- 22 securities bureau in carrying out its duties required by law
