'Revised probate code '

being section 700 609 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT -

- 4 Sec 609 (1) IN ESTATES OF DECEDENTS DYING BEFORE OCTOBER
- 5 1 1993 1 OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES
- 6 (A) The safe deposit box of which a decedent was an individ-
- 7 ual or joint lessee may be opened following his OR HER death
- 8 only upon compliance with THE MICHIGAN ESTATE TAX ACT, Act
- 9 No 188 of the Public Acts of 1899, as amended, being sections
- 10 205 201 to -205 221- 205 256 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

- 1 (B)  $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$  The safe deposit box of a person who is an
- 2 individual or joint lessee and for whom a fiduciary was appointed
- 3 may be opened by that fiduciary in a like manner as provided by
- 4 Act No 188 of the Public Acts of 1899 as amended, as it
- 5 relates to deceased persons and the fiduciary shall pay to the
- 6 county treasurer the fees and mileage as provided in that act
- 7 (2) IN ESTATES OF DECEDENTS DYING AFTER SEPTEMBER 30 1993
- 8 1 OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES
- 9 (A) IF IT APPEARS TO THE COURT BY PETITION OF AN INTERESTED
- 10 PARTY THAT A SAFE AND COLLATERAL DEPOSIT COMPANY TRUST COMPANY
- 11 CORPORATION, BANK OR OTHER INSTITUTION HAS LEASED TO A DECEDENT,
- 12 EITHER AS AN INDIVIDUAL OR JOINT LESSEE, A SAFE DEPOSIT BOX IN
- 13 THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PROBATE COURT HAS JURISDICTION AND THAT
- 14 THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX MAY CONTAIN A WILL OF THE DECEDENT OR A DEED
- 15 TO A BURIAL PLOT IN WHICH THE DECEDENT IS TO BE INTERRED, THE
- 16 COURT MAY MAKE AN ORDER DIRECTING THAT INSTITUTION TO PERMIT THE
- 17 PERSON NAMED IN THE ORDER TO EXAMINE THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX IN THE
- 18 PRESENCE OF AN OFFICER OR OTHER AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THAT
- 19 INSTITUTION AND IF A PAPER PURPORTING TO BE A WILL OF THE DECE-
- 20 DENT OR A DEED TO A BURIAL PLOT IS FOUND IN THE BOX, TO DELIVER
- 21 THE WILL OR DEED TO THE PROBATE REGISTER OR HIS OR HER DEPUTY
- 22 THE PROBATE REGISTER OR HIS OR HER DEPUTY SHALL FURNISH A RECEIPT
- 23 TO THE INSTITUTION ITEMS CONTAINED IN THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX
- 24 OTHER THAN THE WILL OR DEED SHALL NOT BE REMOVED FROM THE SAFE
- 25 DEPOSIT BOX AT THE TIME OF THE OPENING OF THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX,
- 26 ALL PERSONS IN ATTENDANCE SHALL EXECUTE A WRITTEN STATEMENT
- 27 CERTIFYING WHETHER ANY WILL OR DEED TO A BURIAL PLOT WAS FOUND

- I AND THAT NO OTHER ITEMS WERE REMOVED FROM THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX
- 2 THAT WRITTEN STATEMENT SHALL BE DELIVERED WITHIN 7 DAYS TO THE
- 3 PROBATE REGISTER OR HIS OR HER DEPUTY BEFORE THE COURT SHALL
- 4 ENTER THE ORDER, THE INTERESTED PARTY SHALL PAY TO THE PROBATE
- 5 REGISTER A FEE OF \$10 00, WHICH SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE GENERAL
- 6 FUND OF THE COUNTY IF THE DECEDENT S ESTATE IS ADMINISTERED IN
- 7 ANY PROBATE COURT IN THIS STATE, THE INTERESTED PARTY MAKING PAY-
- 8 MENT OF THAT FEE MAY FILE A CLAIM IN THE ESTATE FOR THAT AMOUNT
- 9 WHICH SHALL BE CHARGED AS A COST OF ADMINISTRATION
- 10 (B) THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX OF A PERSON WHO IS AN INDIVIDUAL OR
- 11 JOINT LESSEE AND FOR WHOM A FIDUCIARY WAS APPOINTED UNDER THIS
- 12 ACT MAY BE OPENED BY THAT FIDUCIARY AND ITS CONTENTS REMOVED IF
- 13 THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX IS JOINTLY LEASED THEN THE FIDUCIARY MAY
- 14 EXAMINE THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX IN THE PRESENCE OF AN OFFICER OR
- 15 OTHER AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE SAFE DEPOSIT AND COLLATERAL COM-
- 16 PANY, TRUST COMPANY, CORPORATION, BANK, OR OTHER INSTITUTION AT
- 17 THE TIME OF THE OPENING OF THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX, ALL PERSONS IN
- 18 ATTENDANCE SHALL EXECUTE A WRITTEN STATEMENT CERTIFYING AS TO
- 19 WHAT WAS REMOVED FROM THE SAFE DEPOSIT BOX BY THE FIDUCIARY THE
- 20 FIDUCIARY SHALL SERVE A COPY OF THAT WRITTEN STATEMENT ON THE
- 21 OTHER JOINT LESSEES WITHIN 7 DAYS OF REMOVING THE ITEMS IN THE
- 22 SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED BY THE COURT RULES FOR SERVING NOTICE OF
- 23 AN ACCOUNT ON AN INTERESTED PARTY
