



HOUSE BILL No. 5935

November 10 1994 Introduced by Rep Whyman and referred to the Committee on Taxation

A bill to amend section 42 of Act No 243 of the Public Acts of 1959, entitled

An act to define license and regulate trailer coach parks to prescribe the powers and duties of the state health commissioner and other state and local officers to provide for the levy and collection of specific taxes on occupied trailers in trailer coach parks and the disposition of the revenues therefrom to provide remedies and penalties for the violation of this act and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts

being section 125 1042 of the Michigan Compiled Laws

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT

1 Section 1 Section 42 of Act No 243 of the Public Acts of
2 1959 being section 125 1042 of the Michigan Compiled Laws is
3 amended to read as follows

4 Sec 42 The treasurer of the municipality in which a
5 trailer coach park is located shall accept and verify the
6 monthly reports from licensees and collect and disburse the
7 monthly tax payments as ~~hereinafter~~ provided IN THIS ACT The

1 municipal treasurer shall issue a receipt in triplicate for all
2 ~~moneys~~ MONEY collected under this act the original RECEIPT to
3 be given TO the licensee the duplicate to be retained BY THE
4 TREASURER for municipal records and the triplicate together
5 with 50 cents per trailer coach shall be transmitted to the
6 county treasurer who shall issue a receipt ~~therefor~~ FOR THE
7 AMOUNT RECEIVED and credit THE PROCEEDS TO the county general
8 fund The municipal treasurer shall credit the municipal general
9 fund with 50 cents per trailer coach ~~so parked and~~ LOCATED
10 WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY BEGINNING IN 1994 THE MUNICIPAL
11 TREASURER shall transmit ~~to the school district in which the~~
12 ~~trailer coach was parked~~ \$2 00 for each trailer coach ~~so~~
13 parked IN THE MUNICIPALITY TO THE STATE TREASURY FOR CREDIT TO
14 THE STATE SCHOOL AID FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 11 OF ARTICLE IX
15 OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963
