A bill to amend the title and sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 14, and 15 of Act No 440 of the Public Acts of 1988, entitled

'Asbestos workers accreditation act,'

being sections 338 3402, 338 3403, 338 3404, 338 3405, 338 3406, 338 3407, 338 3409, 338 3410, 338 3411, 338 3412, 338 3413, 338 3414, and 338 3415 of the Michigan Compiled Laws and to repeal acts and parts of acts

- 23 the written complaint of an aggrieved party, a state agency, or
- 24 political subdivision may investigate the acts of a person
- 25 accredited under this act The department may deny, suspend, or
- 26 revoke a certificate of accreditation or reaccreditation under
- 27 this act pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969,
