



# SENATE BILL No. 8

January 13, 1993, Introduced by Senator DI NELLO and referred to the Committee on State Affairs and Military/Veteran Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended "The Michigan liquor control act," as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 24a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra  
2 Session of 1933, as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of  
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 24a to  
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 24A. (1) ANY OFF-PREMISES OR ON-PREMISES RETAIL  
6 LICENSEE MAY USE SIGNAGE LOCATED INSIDE THE LICENSED PREMISES SO  
7 LONG AS IT DOES NOT EXCEED 3,500 SQUARE INCHES.

8 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SIGNAGE" MEANS ALL OF THE  
9 FOLLOWING:

1 (A) A SIGN ADVERTISING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

2 (B) A NECESSARY PART OF A SIGN ADVERTISING ALCOHOLIC  
3 LIQUOR.

4 (C) ANY SIGN ATTACHED TO A SIGN ADVERTISING ALCOHOLIC  
5 LIQUOR.
