

## **SENATE BILL No. 11**

January 13, 1993, Introduced by Senator DI NELLO and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism.

A bill to amend section 315 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended
"Michigan vehicle code,"

being section 257.315 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 315 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1949, being section 257.315 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 315. (1) (a) Any operator or chauffeur, who shall
- 5 change his residence previous to the expiration of a license
- 6 granted under this chapter shall immediately return such license
- 7 to the local examining board or the department, whose duty it
- 8 shall be to write the new address on the reverse side of the
- 9 license and the date of change. A PERSON WHO IS THE HOLDER OF AN
- 10 UNEXPIRED OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE SHALL REPORT EACH

- 1 CHANGE OF HIS OR HER RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS TO THE SECRETARY OF
- 2 STATE AND APPLY FOR A CORRECTED LICENSE.
- 3 (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A PERSON
- 4 WHO REPORTS A CHANGE OF HIS OR HER RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS AND
- 5 APPLIES FOR A CORRECTED OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE UNDER
- 6 THIS SECTION SHALL PERSONALLY RETURN THE LICENSE TO THE SECRETARY
- 7 OF STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CORRECT THE OPERATOR'S OR
- 8 CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE BY AFFIXING A LABEL CONTAINING THE CORRECT
- 9 ADDRESS ON THE BACK OF THE LICENSE. THE LABEL CONTAINING THE
- 10 CORRECT ADDRESS SHALL INDICATE THE DATE THAT THE ADDRESS WAS COR-
- 11 RECTED ON THE OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE.
- 12 (3) A PERSON MAY REPORT A CHANGE OF HIS OR HER RESIDENTIAL
- 13 ADDRESS TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND APPLY FOR A CORRECTED
- 14 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION BY MAIL IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE
- 15 SECRETARY OF STATE OR BY TELEPHONE ON A STATEWIDE TOLL-FREE TELE-
- 16 PHONE LINE.
- 17 (4) IF A PERSON REPORTS A CHANGE OF HIS OR HER RESIDENTIAL
- 18 ADDRESS AND MAKES APPLICATION TO CORRECT HIS OR HER OPERATOR'S OR
- 19 CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION BY MAIL OR BY TELEPHONE ON
- 20 A STATEWIDE TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE LINE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 21 SHALL ISSUE A LABEL CONTAINING THE CORRECT ADDRESS OF THE
- 22 LICENSEE. THE LABEL CONTAINING THE CORRECT ADDRESS SHALL INDI-
- 23 CATE THE DATE THAT THE ADDRESS WAS CORRECTED ON THE OPERATOR'S OR
- 24 CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAIL THE LABEL
- 25 CONTAINING THE CORRECT ADDRESS TO THE LICENSEE WHO SHALL AFFIX IT
- 26 TO THE BACK OF HIS OR HER OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE.

- 1 (5) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A
- 2 STATEWIDE TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE LINE TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- 3 (6) -(b) Failure to have such IF A PERSON FAILS TO REPORT A
- 4 change of HIS OR HER RESIDENTIAL address -recorded as herein pro-
- 5 vided may be cause for revocation or suspension of same
- 6 immediately AND APPLY FOR A CORRECTED OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S
- 7 LICENSE AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, HE OR SHE MAY IMMEDIATELY
- 8 HAVE HIS OR HER LICENSE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED if there is no
- 9 response to a notice mailed to his OR HER last known address.
