

SENATE BILL No. 300

January 28, 1993, Introdued by Senator BOUCHARD and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled

"Open meetings act,"

being section 15.262 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1976, being section 15.262 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended is to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 5 (a) "Public body" means any state or local legislative or
- 6 governing body, including a board, commission, committee, subcom-
- 7 mittee, authority, or council, -which THAT is empowered by state
- 8 constitution, statute, charter, ordinance, resolution, or rule to
- 9 exercise governmental or proprietary authority or perform a
- 10 governmental or proprietary function, or a lessee thereof

performing an essential public purpose and function pursuant to the lease agreement.

- (b) "Meeting" means the convening of a public body at which a quorum is present for the purpose of DISCUSSING ISSUES OF PUBLIC POLICY OR deliberating toward or rendering a decision on a public policy, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER A RECORD OF THE DISCUSSION, DELIBERATION, OR DECISION IS KEPT.
- (c) "Closed session" means a meeting or part of a meeting of a public body —which— THAT is closed to the public.
- (d) "Decision" means a determination, action, vote, or disposition upon a motion, proposal, recommendation, resolution, order, ordinance, bill, or measure on which a vote by members of a public body is required and by which a public body effectuates or formulates public policy.
