

SENATE BILL No. 322

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Senator EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Family Law, Criminal Law, and Corrections.

A bill to amend section 2 of chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, entitled

"Of marriage and the solemnization thereof,"
being section 551.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal
certain parts of the act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes
- 2 of 1846, being section 551.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2. Marriage, so far as its validity in law is con-
- 5 cerned, is a civil contract, to which the consent of parties
- 6 capable in law of contracting, is essential. A PARTY HAS THE
- 7 MENTAL CAPACITY TO CONSENT TO MARRIAGE IF HE OR SHE UNDERSTANDS
- 8 THE NATURE OF THE MARRIAGE RELATIONSHIP AND THE DUTIES AND
- 9 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THAT RELATIONSHIP. A PERSON IS PRESUMED TO

- 1 HAVE THE MENTAL CAPACITY TO ENTER INTO A MARRIAGE CONTRACT EXCEPT
- 2 FOR A PERSON FOR WHOM A GUARDIAN HAS BEEN APPOINTED BY THE PRO-
- 3 BATE COURT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 6 OF THE MENTAL HEALTH CODE, ACT
- 4 NO. 258 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1974, BEING SECTIONS 330.1600 TO
- 5 330.1642 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, OR ARTICLE 4 OF THE
- 6 REVISED PROBATE CODE, ACT NO. 642 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978,
- 7 BEING SECTIONS 700.401 TO 700.499 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS,
- 8 BUT ONLY IF THERE HAS BEEN A SPECIFIC FINDING BY THE PROBATE
- 9 COURT THAT THE PERSON LACKS THE CAPACITY TO ENTER INTO A MARRIAGE
- 10 CONTRACT. Consent alone will not be enough to effectuate a legal
- 11 marriage from and after January 1, 1957. Consent must be fol-
- 12 lowed by the issuance of a license -as provided for by PURSUANT
- 13 TO section 1 of Act No. 128 of the Public Acts of 1887, as
- 14 amended, being section 551.101 of the MICHIGAN Compiled Laws, -of
- 15 1948, or as provided for by section 1 of Act No. 180 of the
- 16 Public Acts of 1897, as amended, being section 551.201 of the
- 17 MICHIGAN Compiled Laws, of 1948, and solemnization, as autho-
- 18 rized by sections 7 to 18. -, inclusive, of this act.
- 19 Section 2. Section 6 of chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes
- 20 of 1846, being section 551.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 21 repealed.
