

SENATE BILL No. 383

February 10, 1993, Introduced by Senator EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 320 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"An act authorizing counties, cities, villages, and townships, either individually or jointly by agreement, to provide a sanitary means of disposing of the solid waste, refuse, garbage, sewage, night soil, and storm water thereof; to supply water thereto; to charge owners or occupants of premises therefor; to borrow money and issue bonds to own, acquire, construct, equip, operate, and maintain waterworks systems, intercepting sewers, other sanitary and storm sewers, sewage disposal plants, transfer stations, and garbage or refuse processing or disposal plants; and to provide for the levying of taxes without limitation as to rate or amount for the repayment of such bonds,"

being section 123.241 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 320 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1927, being section 123.241 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
 - Sec. 1. (1) A -county, city, village, or township in this
- 5 state, either individually or jointly by agreement, is authorized

- 1 to GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY own, acquire,
- 2 construct, equip, operate, and maintain ANY OF THE FOLLOWING
- 3 either within or without the statutory or corporate limits of the
- 4 governmental -agencies AGENCY or -municipalities, intercepting-
- 5 MUNICIPALITY:
- 6 (A) INTERCEPTING sewers, other sanitary and storm sewers,
- 7 pumping stations, and a plant or plants for the treatment, pro-
- 8 cessing, purification, and disposal in a sanitary manner,
- 9 approved by the department of natural resources, of the liquid
- 10 and solid wastes, refuse, sewage, and night soil, storm water,
- 11 and garbage of those THAT governmental agencies and municipal-
- 12 ities and AGENCY OR MUNICIPALITY.
- 13 (B) A SYSTEM OF DISPOSAL OF STORM WATER THAT MAY INCLUDE
- 14 INTERCEPTING STORM SEWERS, PIPES, DRAINS, A DETENTION OR RETEN-
- 15 TION POND OR PONDS, A PUMP, A PUMPING FACILITY, A TREATMENT
- 16 FACILITY, AND ANY OTHER ITEM NECESSARY TO OPERATE A STORM WATER
- 17 DISPOSAL SYSTEM.
- 18 (C) A waterworks SYSTEM OR systems approved by the depart-
- 19 ment of public health, -including such THAT MAY INCLUDE facili-
- 20 ties SUCH as water mains, treatment works, source facilities,
- 21 pumping stations, reservoirs, storage tanks, -and- OR other
- 22 appurtenances for the purpose of obtaining, treating, and deliv-
- 23 ering pure and wholesome water in adequate quantity to -those-
- 24 THAT governmental -agencies and municipalities. They AGENCY OR
- 25 MUNICIPALITY.
- 26 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), A GOVERNMENTAL
- 27 AGENCY OR MUNICIPALITY may acquire by gift, grant, purchase, or

- 1 condemnation necessary lands therefor, either REAL PROPERTY
- 2 within or without the statutory or corporate limits of the gov-
- 3 ernmental -agencies AGENCY or -municipalities. However,
- 4 townships MUNICIPALITY FOR PURPOSES DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION.
- 5 (3) A TOWNSHIP shall not -have the power of condemnation
- 6 outside their CONDEMN PROPERTY UNDER THIS ACT IF THAT PROPERTY
- 7 IS OUTSIDE THE TOWNSHIP'S corporate limits. For the purpose of
- 8 acquiring property for -the- uses -herein mentioned the-
- 9 DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, governmental agencies or municipali-
- 10 ties -may invoke and shall have all the rights, powers, and
- 11 privileges granted to -- public corporations -- under Act
- 12 No. 149 of the Public Acts of 1911, as amended, being sections
- 13 213.21 to -213.41 213.25 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, -and
- 14 which shall be in addition to any powers granted to the govern-
- 15 mental agencies by statute or municipalities by their charters.
- 16 (4) AS USED IN THIS ACT:
- 17 (A) "GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR MUNICIPALITY" MEANS A COUNTY,
- 18 CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP, OR ANY COMBINATION OF COUNTIES,
- 19 CITIES, VILLAGES, OR TOWNSHIPS ACTING PURSUANT TO AN AGREEMENT
- 20 UNDER THIS ACT.
- 21 (B) "SEWAGE" MEANS SANITARY SEWAGE, STORM WATER, OR BOTH.
- 22 (C) "SEWER" MEANS A SANITARY SEWER, A STORM SEWER, OR A COM-
- 23 BINED SANITARY AND STORM SEWER.
