

SENATE BILL No. 403

February 18, 1993, Introduced by Senator PRIDNIA and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend section 14 of Act No. 48 of the Public Acts of 1929, entitled as amended

"An act levying a specific tax to be known as the severance tax upon all producers engaged in the business of severing oil and gas from the soil; prescribing the method of collecting the tax; requiring all producers of such products or purchasers thereof to make reports; to provide penalties; to provide exemptions and refunds; to prescribe the disposition of the funds so collected; and to exempt those paying such specific tax from certain other taxes,"

being section 205.314 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 14 of Act No. 48 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1929, being section 205.314 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 14. (1) All taxes shall accompany the report provided
- 5 for in section 2. Except as provided in subsection (2), all
- 6 taxes, penalties, or costs paid to the state tax commission under

- 1 this act shall be paid into the state treasury and shall be
- 2 credited AS FOLLOWS:
- 3 (A) TWO PERCENT OF THE REVENUE RECEIVED DURING EACH FISCAL
- 4 YEAR, BUT NOT LESS THAN \$1,000,000.00 SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE
- 5 ORPHAN WELL FUND CREATED IN SECTION 23B OF ACT NO. 61 OF THE
- 6 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1939, BEING SECTION 319.23B OF THE MICHIGAN
- 7 COMPILED LAWS.
- 8 (B) THE REMAINING REVENUE RECEIVED DURING EACH FISCAL YEAR
- 9 THAT IS NOT ALLOCATED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION (A) SHALL BE
- 10 CREDITED to the general fund of the state -where-they AND shall
- 11 be available for any purpose for which the general fund is made
- 12 available by law.
- 13 (2) The revenue collected under subsection (1) in excess of
- 14 \$16,000,000.00, shall be deposited in the general fund and shall
- 15 be allocated for the payment of credits for heating fuel costs
- 16 provided under section 527a of Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of
- 17 1967, being section 206.527a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, for
- 18 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1980 only.
- Section 2. This amendatory act shall take effect October 1,
- 20 1993.
- 21 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
