



SENATE BILL No. 444

February 25, 1993, Introduced by Senators GAST and HOLMES
and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of education and certain other purposes relating to education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of education and
2 certain state purposes related to education as set forth in this act for
3 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, from the following funds:
