

SENATE BILL No. 451

February 25, 1993, Introduced by Senators GAST and HOLMES and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of commerce and the department of labor and certain other state purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agencies.
