



SENATE BILL No. 460

February 25, 1993, Introduced by Senators KELLY, SMITH, VAUGHN, HOLMES, O'BRIEN and FAUST and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Development.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 41 of the Public Acts of 1960, entitled

"An act to regulate the hours that children under the age of 16 years may be in or on the public streets, highways, alleys and parks; and to prescribe penalties for violations of the provisions of this act,"

being section 722.754 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 41 of the Public Acts of
2 1960, being section 722.754 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 4. (1) ~~Nothing in this act shall be deemed to limit~~
5 ~~any powers now or hereafter~~ THIS ACT DOES NOT LIMIT THE POWERS
6 possessed by law by ~~any~~ A township, charter township, city, or
7 village to regulate by ordinance a curfew of minors.

1 (2) IF A TOWNSHIP, CHARTER TOWNSHIP, CITY, OR VILLAGE
2 ESTABLISHES A CURFEW ORDINANCE FOR MINORS, THE CURFEW ORDINANCE
3 MAY PROVIDE IN ADDITION TO, OR IN LIEU OF, ANY OTHER PENALTY OR
4 DISPOSITION FOR THE IMPOSITION OF NOT MORE THAN 60 DAYS OF COMMU-
5 NITY SERVICE, TO BE PERFORMED ON WEEKENDS OR AT OTHER TIMES THAT
6 DO NOT CONFLICT WITH THE MINOR'S SCHOOL OR WORK HOURS.
