

## **SENATE BILL No. 686**

June 8, 1993, Introduced by Senators O'BRIEN, DI NELLO, HART, PRIDNIA and DUNASKISS and referred to the Committee on State Affairs and Military/Veteran Affairs.

A bill to amend sections 2, 4, 6, 8, and 23 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled as amended "Marine safety act,"

section 2 as amended by Act No. 56 of the Public Acts of 1988 and section 8 as amended by Act No. 183 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 281.1002, 281.1004, 281.1006, 281.1008, and 281.1023 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 2, 4, 6, 8, and 23 of Act No. 303 of
- 2 the Public Acts of 1967, section 2 as amended by Act No. 56 of
- 3 the Public Acts of 1988 and section 8 as amended by Act No. 183
- 4 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 281.1002, 281.1004,
- 5 281.1006, 281.1008, and 281.1023 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,

6 are amended to read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Waters of this state" means any waters within the ter-
- 3 ritorial limits of this state, and includes those waters of the
- 4 Great Lakes which are under the jurisdiction of this state.
- 5 (b) "Commission" means the commission of natural resources.
- 6 (c) "Council" means the marine safety advisory council cre-
- 7 ated in section 11.
- 8 (d) "Dealer" means a person who annually purchases from a
- 9 manufacturer, or is engaged in selling or manufacturing, 6 or
- 10 more vessels that require certificates of number under this act,
- 11 and includes the authorized representative of the dealer.
- (e) "Department" means the department of natural resources.
- 13 (f) "Director" means the director of the department of natu-
- 14 ral resources.
- 15 (g) "Political subdivision" means any county, metropolitan
- 16 authority, city, village, township, or combination thereof in
- 17 this state. Whenever a body of water is located in more than 1
- 18 political subdivision, all of the subdivisions shall act individ-
- 19 ually in order to comply with the provisions of this act, except
- 20 if the problem is confined to a specific area of the body of
- 21 water only the political subdivision in which the problem waters
- 22 <del>lie shall act.</del>
- 23 (h) "State of principal use" means the state on whose waters
- 24 a vessel is used or is to be used most during a calendar year.
- 25 (i) "Issuing authority" means a state that has a numbering
- 26 system approved by the United States coast guard, or the United
- 27 States coast guard if a numbering system is not approved.

- 1 (A) "ANCHORED RAFTS" MEANS ALL TYPES OF NONPOWERED RAFTS
- 2 USED FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES THAT ARE ANCHORED SEASONALLY ON
- 3 WATERS OF THIS STATE.
- (B) "ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING THAT
- 5 ARE NOT RADIO EQUIPMENT:
- 6 (i) AN ORIGINAL SYSTEM, PART, OR COMPONENT OF A BOAT AT THE
- 7 TIME THAT BOAT WAS MANUFACTURED, OR A SIMILAR PART OR COMPONENT
- A MANUFACTURED OR SOLD FOR REPLACEMENT.
- 9 (ii) REPAIR OR IMPROVEMENT OF AN ORIGINAL OR REPLACEMENT
- 10 SYSTEM, PART, OR COMPONENT.
- 11 (iii) AN ACCESSORY OR EQUIPMENT FOR, OR APPURTENANCE TO, A
- 12 BOAT.
- 13 (iv) A MARINE SAFETY ARTICLE, ACCESSORY, OR EQUIPMENT
- 14 INTENDED FOR USE BY A PERSON ON BOARD A BOAT.
- 15 (C) "BOAT" MEANS A VESSEL.
- 16 (D) "BOAT LIVERY" MEANS A BUSINESS THAT HOLDS A VESSEL FOR
- 17 RENTING, LEASING, OR CHARTERING.
- 18 (E) "COMMISSION" MEANS THE COMMISSION OF NATURAL RESOURCES.
- 19 (F) "CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 20 SECTION 7104 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, ACT NO. 368 OF THE PUBLIC
- 21 ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTION 333.7104 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED
- 22 LAWS.
- 23 (G) "CONVICTION" MEANS A FINAL CONVICTION, THE PAYMENT OF A
- 24 FINE, A PLEA OF GUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE IF ACCEPTED BY THE
- 25 COURT, A FINDING OF GUILT, OR A PROBATE COURT DISPOSITION ON A
- 26 VIOLATION OF THIS ACT, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE PENALTY IS
- 27 REBATED OR SUSPENDED.

- 1 (H) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE MARINE SAFETY EDUCATION ADVISORY
- 2 COUNCIL CREATED UNDER SECTION 11B.
- 3 Sec. 4. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Marine safety program" means marine law enforcement,
- 5 search and rescue operations, water safety education, recovery of
- 6 drowned bodies and boat livery inspections.
- 7 (b) "State aid" means payment made by the state to a county
- 8 for the conduct of a marine safety program.
- 9 (c) "Authorized expenditures" means those expenditures
- 10 determined by the director to be reasonable and necessary for the
- 11 adequate and proper conduct of a marine safety program. The
- 12 director shall prepare and maintain a schedule of such authorized
- 13 expenditures and amend the same from time to time.
- 14 (A) "DEALER" MEANS A PERSON AND AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE
- 15 OF THAT PERSON WHO ANNUALLY PURCHASES FROM A MANUFACTURER, OR WHO
- 16 IS ENGAGED IN SELLING OR MANUFACTURING, 6 OR MORE VESSELS THAT
- 17 REQUIRE CERTIFICATES OF NUMBER UNDER THIS ACT.
- 18 (B) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.
- 19 (C) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATU-
- 20 RAL RESOURCES.
- 21 (D) "ISSUING AUTHORITY" MEANS THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD
- 22 OR A STATE THAT HAS A NUMBERING SYSTEM APPROVED BY THE UNITED
- 23 STATES COAST GUARD.
- 24 (E) "LAW OF ANOTHER STATE" MEANS A LAW OR ORDINANCE ENACTED
- 25 BY ANOTHER STATE OR BY A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT IN ANOTHER
- 26 STATE.

- 1 (F) "LIFEBOAT" MEANS A SMALL BOAT DESIGNATED AND USED SOLELY
- 2 FOR LIFESAVING PURPOSES, AND DOES NOT INCLUDE A DINGHY, TENDER,
- 3 SPEEDBOAT, OR OTHER TYPE OF CRAFT THAT IS NOT CARRIED ABOARD A
- 4 VESSEL FOR LIFESAVING PURPOSES.
- 5 (G) "LONG-TERM INCAPACITATING INJURY" MEANS AN INJURY THAT
- 6 CAUSES A PERSON TO BE IN A COMATOSE, QUADRIPLEGIC, HEMIPLEGIC, OR
- 7 PARAPLEGIC STATE, WHICH STATE IS LIKELY TO CONTINUE FOR 1 YEAR OR
- 8 MORE.
- 9 Sec. 6. As used in this act:
- 10 (a) "Boating safety certificate" means a certificate issued
- 11 by the director evidencing that the holder has successfully com-
- 12 pleted a state approved course of instruction in boating safety.
- 13 (b) "Vessel" means every description of watercraft, other
- 14 than a seaplane on the water, used or capable of being used as a
- 15 means of transportation on water.
- 16 (c) "Motorboat" means a vessel propelled by machinery,
- 17 whether or not machinery is the principal source of propulsion.
- 18 (d) "Lifeboat" means a small boat designated and used solely
- 19 for lifesaving purposes, and does not include dinghies, tenders,
- 20 speedboats, or other types of craft carried aboard vessels and
- 21 used for other than lifesaving purposes.
- 22 (e) "Person" means an individual, partnership, firm, corpo-
- 23 ration, company, association, or governmental entity, and
- 24 <del>includes a trustee, receiver, assignee or similar representative</del>
- 25 of any of them.

- 1 (f) "Owner" means a person who claims lawful possession of a
- 2 vessel by virtue of legal title or equitable interest therein
- 3 which entitles him to the possession.
- 4 (g) "Boat" means a vessel which is manufactured or used pri-
- 5 marily for noncommercial use; leased, rented, or chartered to
- 6 another for the latter's noncommercial use; or engaged in the
- 7 carrying of not more than 6 passengers.
- 8 (h) "Associated equipment" means a system, part, or compo-
- 9 nent of a boat as originally manufactured, or a similar part or
- 10 component manufactured or sold for replacement, repair or
- 11 improvement of the system, part, or component; an accessory or
- 12 equipment for, or appurtenance to, a boat; or a marine safety
- 13 article, accessory, or equipment intended for use by a person on
- 14 board a boat. It does not include radio equipment.
- 15 (i) "Operator" means the person who is in control or in
- 16 charge of a vessel while it is in use.
- 17 (j) "Passenger" means a person carried on board a vessel
- 18 other than the owner or his representative; the operator; bona
- 19 fide members of the crew engaged in the business of the vessel
- 20 who have not contributed consideration for their carriage and who
- 21 are paid for their services; or a guest on board a vessel which
- 22 is being used exclusively for pleasure purposes who has not con-
- 23 tributed consideration, directly or indirectly, for his
- 24 carriage.
- 25 (k) "Undocumented vessel" means a vessel which does not
- 26 have, and is not required to have, a valid marine document issued

- 1 by the United States coast guard or federal agency successor
- 2 thereto.
- 3 (1) "Use" means operate, navigate, or employ.
- 4 (m) "Boat livery" means a business which holds a vessel for
- 5 renting, leasing, or chartering.
- 6 (n) "Manufacturer" means a person engaged in the manufac-
- 7 ture, construction, or assembly of boats or associated equipment;
- 8 the manufacture or construction of components for boats and asso-
- 9 ciated equipment to be sold for subsequent assembly; or the
- 10 importation of a boat or associated equipment into the state for
- 11 sale.
- 12 (A) "MANUFACTURER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN ANY OF THE
- 13 FOLLOWING:
- 14 (i) THE MANUFACTURE, CONSTRUCTION, OR ASSEMBLY OF BOATS OR
- 15 ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT.
- 16 (ii) THE MANUFACTURE OR CONSTRUCTION OF COMPONENTS FOR BOATS
- 17 AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT TO BE SOLD FOR SUBSEQUENT ASSEMBLY.
- 18 (iii) THE IMPORTATION OF A BOAT OR ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT INTO
- 19 THE STATE FOR SALE.
- 20 (B) "MARINE LAW" MEANS THIS ACT OR A LOCAL ORDINANCE OR RULE
- 21 ESTABLISHED IN CONFORMITY WITH THIS ACT.
- 22 (C) "MARINE SAFETY PROGRAM" MEANS MARINE LAW ENFORCEMENT,
- 23 SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATIONS, WATER SAFETY EDUCATION, RECOVERY OF
- 24 DROWNED BODIES AND BOAT LIVERY INSPECTIONS.
- 25 (D) "MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE" MEANS ACT NO. 300 OF THE PUBLIC
- 26 ACTS OF 1949, BEING SECTIONS 257.1 TO 257.923 OF THE MICHIGAN
- 27 COMPILED LAWS.

- 1 (E) "MOTORBOAT" MEANS A VESSEL PROPELLED WHOLLY OR IN PART
- 2 BY MACHINERY.
- 3 (F) "OPERATE" MEANS TO BE IN CONTROL OF A VESSEL WHILE THE
- 4 VESSEL IS UNDERWAY AND IS NOT SECURED IN SOME MANNER SUCH AS
- 5 BEING DOCKED OR AT ANCHOR.
- 6 (G) "OPERATOR" MEANS THE PERSON WHO IS IN CONTROL OR IN
- 7 CHARGE OF A VESSEL WHILE THAT VESSEL IS UNDERWAY.
- 8 (H) "OWNER" MEANS A PERSON WHO CLAIMS OR IS ENTITLED TO
- 9 LAWFUL POSSESSION OF A VESSEL BY VIRTUE OF THAT PERSON'S LEGAL
- 10 TITLE OR EQUITABLE INTEREST IN A VESSEL.
- 11 Sec. 8. As used in this act:
- 12 (a) "Operate" means to navigate or otherwise use a vessel.
- 13 (b) "Slow-no wake speed" means a very slow speed whereby
- 14 the wake or wash created by the vessel would be minimal.
- 15 (c) "High speed boating" means a speed at or above which a
- 16 motorboat reaches a planning condition.
- 17 (d) "Regatta", "boat race", "marine parade", "tournament",
- 18 or "exhibition" each mean an organized water event of limited
- 19 duration which is conducted according to a prearranged schedule.
- 20 (e) "Anchored rafts" means all types of nonpowered rafts
- 21 used for recreational purposes which are anchored seasonally on
- 22 waters of this state.
- 23 (f) "Starboard" means right and reference is to the star-
- 24 board side of a vessel or to the right side of the vessel.
- 25 (g) "Personal watercraft" means a vessel that meets all of
- 26 the following requirements:

- 1 (i) Uses a motor-driven propeller or an internal combustion
- 2 engine powering a water jet pump as its primary source of
- 3 propulsion.
- 4 (ii) Is designed without an open load carrying area that
- 5 would retain water.
- 6 (iii) Is designed to be operated by 1 or more persons posi-
- 7 tioned on, rather than within, the confines of the hull.
- 8 (h) "Port" means left and reference is to the port side of a
- yessel or to the left side of the vessel.
- 10 (A) "PASSENGER" MEANS A PERSON CARRIED ON BOARD A VESSEL
- 11 OTHER THAN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 12 (i) THE OWNER OR HIS OR HER REPRESENTATIVE.
- 13 (ii) THE OPERATOR.
- 14 (B) "PEACE OFFICER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2
- 15 OF THE CHARTER AND LIVERY BOAT SAFETY ACT, ACT NO. 244 OF THE
- 16 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1986, BEING SECTION 281.572 OF THE MICHIGAN
- 17 COMPILED LAWS.
- 18 (C) "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, FIRM, CORPO-
- 19 RATION, COMPANY, ASSOCIATION, OR GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, AND
- 20 INCLUDES A TRUSTEE, RECEIVER, ASSIGNEE OR SIMILAR REPRESENTATIVE
- 21 OF ANY OF THEM.
- 22 (D) "PERSONAL WATERCRAFT" MEANS A VESSEL THAT MEETS ALL OF
- 23 THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 24 (i) USES A MOTOR-DRIVEN PROPELLER OR AN INTERNAL COMBUSTION
- 25 ENGINE POWERING A WATER JET PUMP AS ITS PRIMARY SOURCE OF
- 26 PROPULSION.

- 1 (ii) IS DESIGNED WITHOUT AN OPEN LOAD CARRYING AREA THAT
- 2 WOULD RETAIN WATER.
- 3 (iii) IS DESIGNED TO BE OPERATED BY 1 OR MORE PERSONS POSI-
- 4 TIONED ON, RATHER THAN WITHIN, THE CONFINES OF THE HULL.
- 5 (E) "POLITICAL SUBDIVISION" MEANS ANY COUNTY, METROPOLITAN
- 6 AUTHORITY, CITY, VILLAGE, TOWNSHIP, OR COMBINATION THEREOF IN
- 7 THIS STATE. WHENEVER A BODY OF WATER IS LOCATED IN MORE THAN 1
- 8 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, ALL OF THE SUBDIVISIONS SHALL ACT INDIVID-
- 9 UALLY IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT, EXCEPT
- 10 IF THE PROBLEM IS CONFINED TO A SPECIFIC AREA OF THE BODY OF
- 11 WATER ONLY THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH THE PROBLEM WATERS
- 12 LIE SHALL ACT.
- 13 (F) "PORT" MEANS LEFT AND REFERENCE IS TO THE PORT SIDE OF A
- 14 VESSEL OR TO THE LEFT SIDE OF THE VESSEL.
- 15 (G) "PROBATE COURT DISPOSITION" MEANS THE ENTRY OF A PROBATE
- 16 COURT ORDER OF DISPOSITION FOR A CHILD FOUND TO BE WITHIN THE
- 17 PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER XIIA OF ACT NO. 288 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF
- 18 1939, BEING SECTIONS 712A.1 TO 712A.28 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED
- 19 LAWS.
- 20 (H) "PROSECUTING ATTORNEY", EXCEPT AS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE
- 21 REQUIRES, MEANS THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF
- 22 A COUNTY, OR THE ATTORNEY REPRESENTING A LOCAL UNIT OF
- 23 GOVERNMENT.
- 24 (I) "REGATTA", "BOAT RACE", "MARINE PARADE", "TOURNAMENT",
- 25 OR "EXHIBITION" MEANS AN ORGANIZED WATER EVENT OF LIMITED DURA-
- 26 TION WHICH IS CONDUCTED ACCORDING TO A PREARRANGED SCHEDULE.

- 1 (J) "SLOW--NO WAKE SPEED" MEANS A VERY SLOW SPEED WHEREBY
- 2 THE WAKE OR WASH CREATED BY THE VESSEL WOULD BE MINIMAL.
- 3 (K) "STARBOARD" MEANS RIGHT AND REFERENCE IS TO THE STAR-
- 4 BOARD SIDE OF A VESSEL OR TO THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE VESSEL.
- 5 (1) "STATE AID" MEANS PAYMENT MADE BY THE STATE TO A COUNTY
- 6 FOR THE CONDUCT OF A MARINE SAFETY PROGRAM.
- 7 (M) "UNDOCUMENTED VESSEL" MEANS A VESSEL WHICH DOES NOT
- 8 HAVE, AND IS NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE, A VALID MARINE DOCUMENT ISSUED
- 9 BY THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD OR FEDERAL AGENCY SUCCESSOR
- 10 THERETO.
- 11 (N) "UNIFORM INSPECTION DECAL" MEANS AN ADHESIVE-BACKED
- 12 STICKER CREATED BY THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 161 THAT IS
- 13 COLOR CODED TO INDICATE THE YEAR THAT IT EXPIRES AND IS ATTACHED
- 14 TO A VESSEL IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED FOR DECALS IN SECTION 31
- 15 WHEN A PEACE OFFICER INSPECTS AND DETERMINES THAT THE VESSEL COM-
- 16 PLIES WITH THIS ACT.
- 17 (O) "USE" MEANS OPERATE, NAVIGATE, OR EMPLOY.
- 18 (P) "VESSEL" MEANS EVERY DESCRIPTION OF WATERCRAFT USED OR
- 19 CAPABLE OF BEING USED AS A MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION ON WATER
- 20 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A SEAPLANE ON THE WATER.
- 21 (Q) "WATERS OF THIS STATE" MEANS ANY WATERS WITHIN THE TER-
- 22 RITORIAL LIMITS OF THIS STATE, AND INCLUDES THOSE WATERS OF THE
- 23 GREAT LAKES WHICH ARE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THIS STATE.
- 24 Sec. 23. (1) Each county of the state -shall be- IS enti-
- 25 tled to receive state aid as provided in this act. A county
- 26 board of commissioners desiring to conduct a marine safety
- 27 program shall submit to the department by December 31 of each

- 1 year an estimate of authorized expenditures for the following
- 2 calendar year, in the form and containing the information the
- 3 department requires. The department shall review the entire
- 4 request and may approve the county request for state aid. The
- 5 department shall annually survey the marine safety program of
- 6 each county to assist in determining the amount of state aid to
- 7 be allocated to a county for its marine safety program. In
- 8 making its annual determination of the amount of state aid to be
- 9 allocated to a county, the department shall develop and employ a
- 10 formula which shall include such factors as:
- 11 (a) The number of students to be trained in boating safety
- 12 in any United States coast quard auxiliary, United States power
- 13 squadron or department sponsored marine safety classes.
- 14 (b) The number of boat user days.
- 15 (c) The number of livery boats.
- 16 (d) Program effectiveness measured by comparing the existing
- 17 rate of compliance with current statutes to the acceptable rate
- 18 of compliance determined by the department.
- (e) The number and type of boat access areas requiring a
- 20 county marine safety program.
- 21 (f) The water area of the county.
- 22 (2) A DETERMINATION OF THE AMOUNT OF STATE AID ALLOCATED TO
- 23 A COUNTY UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT BE BASED, WHOLLY OR IN PART,
- 24 UPON THE NUMBER OF VESSELS WITHIN THAT COUNTY THAT ARE STOPPED OR
- 25 INSPECTED UNDER SECTION 161.
- 26 (3) -(2)— State aid allocated to a county under this act
- 27 shall be used exclusively for the conduct of the county marine

- 1 safety program as provided by this act and rules promulgated
- 2 hereunder. Within 90 days after the close of each calendar year,
- 3 a county board of commissioners shall submit to the department a
- 4 statement of authorized expenditures actually incurred, in the
- 5 form and containing the information THAT the department
- 6 requires. Statements A COUNTY THAT PROVIDES THE DEPARTMENT
- 7 WITH STATEMENTS or supplements -thereto received TO STATEMENTS
- 8 subsequent to the 90-day period -shall not be IS NOT eligible
- 9 for state aid UNDER THIS ACT.
- 10 Section 2. Section 3 of Act No. 303 of the Public Acts of
- 11 1967, being section 281.1003 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 12 repealed.
- 13 Section 3. This amendatory act shall take effect April 1,
- 14 1994.
- 15 Section 4. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 16 all of the following bills of the 87th Legislature are enacted
- 17 into law:
