



SENATE BILL No. 715

June 23, 1993, Introduced by Senators KOIVISTO, FAUST, VAUGHN, SMITH, CONROY, DINGELL, CHERRY, HOFFMAN, MILLER, BERRYMAN, HART, POLLACK, KELLY and PRIDNIA and referred to the Committee on Technology and Energy.

A bill to amend section 401 of Act No. 179 of the Public Acts of 1991, entitled
"Michigan telecommunications act,"
being section 484.2401 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 309b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 401 of Act No. 179 of the Public Acts of
2 1991, being section 484.2401 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended and section 309b is added to read as follows:

4 SEC. 309B. THE PROVIDING OF A CELLULAR OR MOBILE TELECOM-
5 MUNICATION SERVICE SHALL BE A REGULATED TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICE
6 UNDER THIS ACT.

7 Sec. 401. (1) Except as otherwise provided by section 305,
8 the commission shall not have authority over enhanced services,
9 paging, ~~cellular, mobile, and~~ answering services, video, cable

1 television, pay-per-view, shared tenant, private networks,
2 financial services networks, radio and television, WATS, personal
3 communication networks, municipally owned telecommunication
4 system, 800 prefix services, and the reselling of a telecommuni-
5 cation service. None of the foregoing shall be considered to be
6 the provision of basic local exchange service.

7 (2) Except as provided in sections 206, 305, 308, and 601,
8 the commission shall not have the authority over a telecommunica-
9 tion service not specifically provided for in this act.
